Highway 404 Widening From Bloomington Road To Aurora Road, Regional Municipality of York (W.P. 433-98-00)

The Study

The Ministry of Transportation is conducting a detail design study to widen Highway 404 from four to six lanes from Bloomington Road to Aurora Road, a distance of 4.5 km. The project involves the addition of a third lane in each direction constructed within the grassed median, widening of the existing twin overpass structures at Bloomington Road and CNR, storm water and drainage improvements, and roadside safety improvements, including guide rail upgrades and rumble strips.

The two inner loop ramps at the Highway 404/Bloomington Road Interchange will be closed for approximately 15 days. Westbound vehicles normally accessing southbound Highway 404 at Bloomington Road will be detoured south on Woodbine Avenue to Stouffville Road and west to Highway 404. Eastbound vehicles normally accessing northbound Highway 404 at Bloomington Road will be detoured north on Bayview Avenue to Aurora Road and east to Highway 404.

A landscape berm will be constructed prior to commencement of construction of this project, on the east side of Highway 404, north of Vandorf Sideroad, within the MTO right-of-way.

The Process

The study is following an approved planning process with the opportunity for public input throughout. Upon completion of the study, a report will be available for public review and comment. Another notice will be published at that time.
