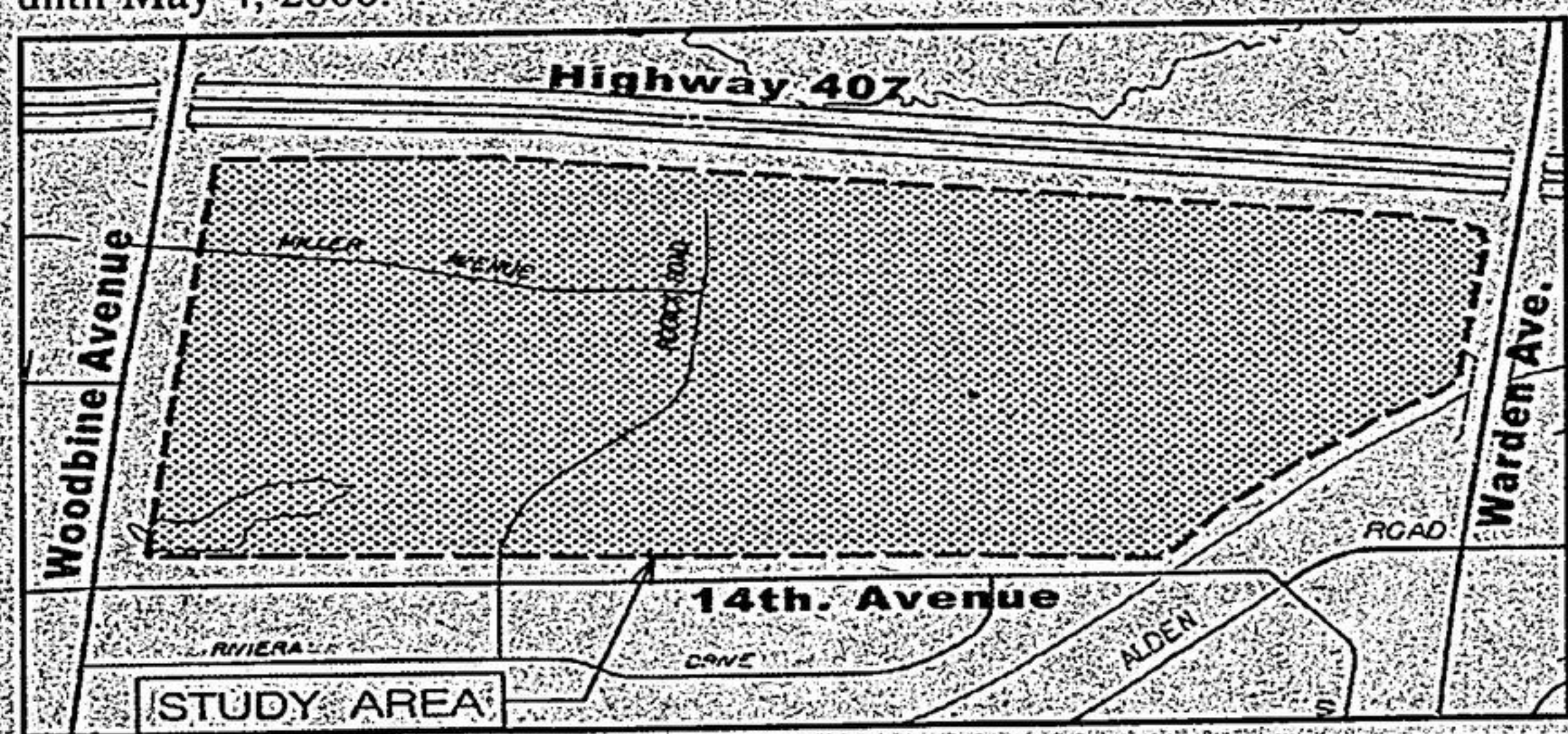
The stormwater management plan is being developed in accordance with Schedule B of the Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Water and Wastewater Projects.

A Proposed Bylaw to Change a Street Name in Accordance with Section 210, Subsection 111 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to pass a bylaw to change the street name of Carter Way to Carter Place on Plan of Subdivision 65M-3358 to maintain consistency with past street naming practice in the Town.

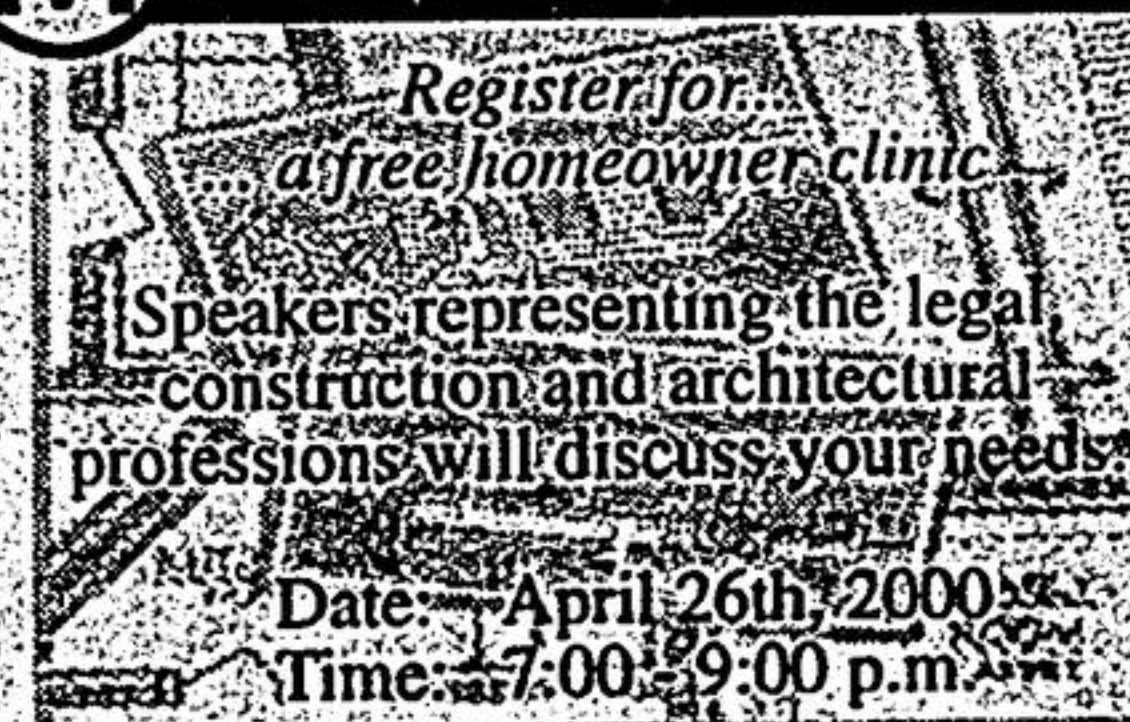
