TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham will hold a public meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, 2000 at the Town of Markham Civic Centre, Council Chamber.

Council is proposing to amend development charges bylaws 147-1999 (Town-Wide Hard Services Bylaw) and 150-1999 to 165-1999 (Area Specific Bylaws), inclusive, to provide exemptions for additions, enlargements and expansions to existing non-residential buildings and structures.

This public meeting will be held pursuant to Section 12 of the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, and all members of the public are invited to attend. The proposed amendments to the aforementioned bylaws will be presented at this meeting. Members of the public will be given the opportunity to make comments regarding the proposed amendments.

The development charge background study and the proposed amendments to the development charge bylaws will be available as of April 19, 2000 from the Clerk's Department, Markham Civic Centre, 101 Town Centre Blvd.

A Proposed Bylaw to Change a Street
 Name in Accordance with Section 210,
 Subsection 111 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to pass a bylaw to change the street name of Carter Way to Carter Place on Plan of Subdivision 65M-3358 to maintain consistency with past street naming practice in the Town.
