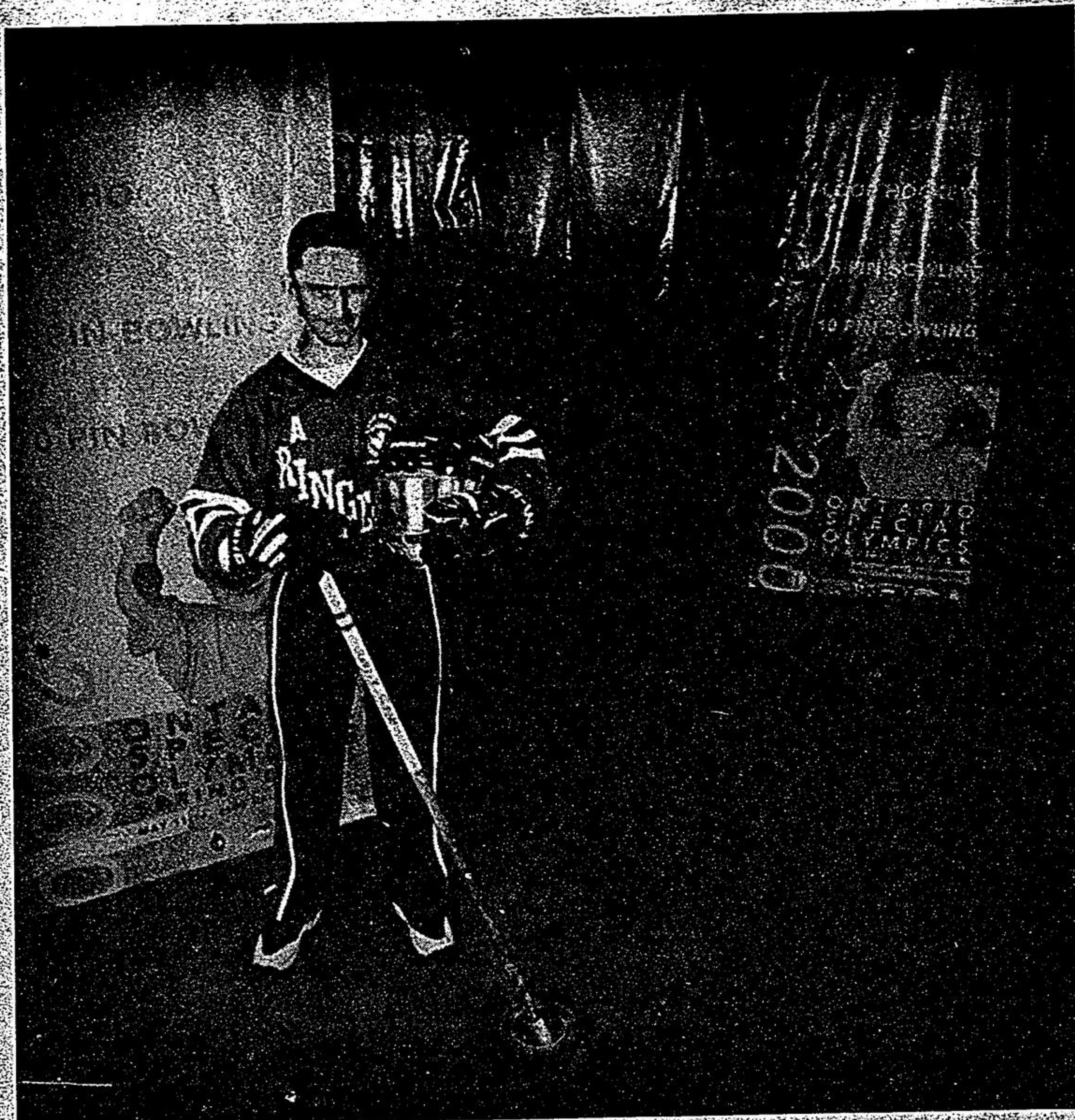

These athletes participate in Special Olympics sports programs and, this year, York Region is host to the 2000 Ontario Special Olympics Spring Games.

Athletes from all over Ontario will compete in one of five sports: five-pin bowling at Stellar Lanes in Newmarket; 10-pin bowling at Club 300 in Markham; powerlifting at St. Andrew's College in Aurora; swimming at Richvale Pool in Richmond Hill; and floor hockey at Garnet A. Williams Community Centre in Vaughan.

You're encouraged to demonstrate your support for the program and the athletes by visiting one of the venues and watching these committed people reach for their goals.

Newmarket's Darryl Taylor is a Special Olympian competing in floor hockey.

Darryl, 32, lives with his mom, Helen Taylor, and his two cats Tigre and Chance (who only has three legs). He helps look after the cats.

"Darryl is very proud of making the floor hockey team," Helen says. "He's a wonderful kid and my best friend."

Darryl has been actively competing and participating in Ontario Special Olympics for the past six years and has previously competed in softball.

He's a real sports fan, according to his mom, and watches all kinds of sports on TV.

Darryl's goals for the future include finding a job and getting married to the girl of his dreams.

### Volunteer of the Week

Anne Young is the director of promotions and marketing for the 2000 Ontario Special Olympic Spring Games.

She works for the York County Hospital Foundation as director of community development. Anne lives in Newmarket with her husband, Stu, and children, Derek and Kylie-Anne.
