Avoid unnecessary damage to the base of the tree. Leave wood chips on the base of the tree. Avoid mounding soil. Use a soaker hose to water the tree. Use mulch to insulate the ground cover at the base of the tree.

The Town of Markham Urban Forestry Department is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy urban forest.



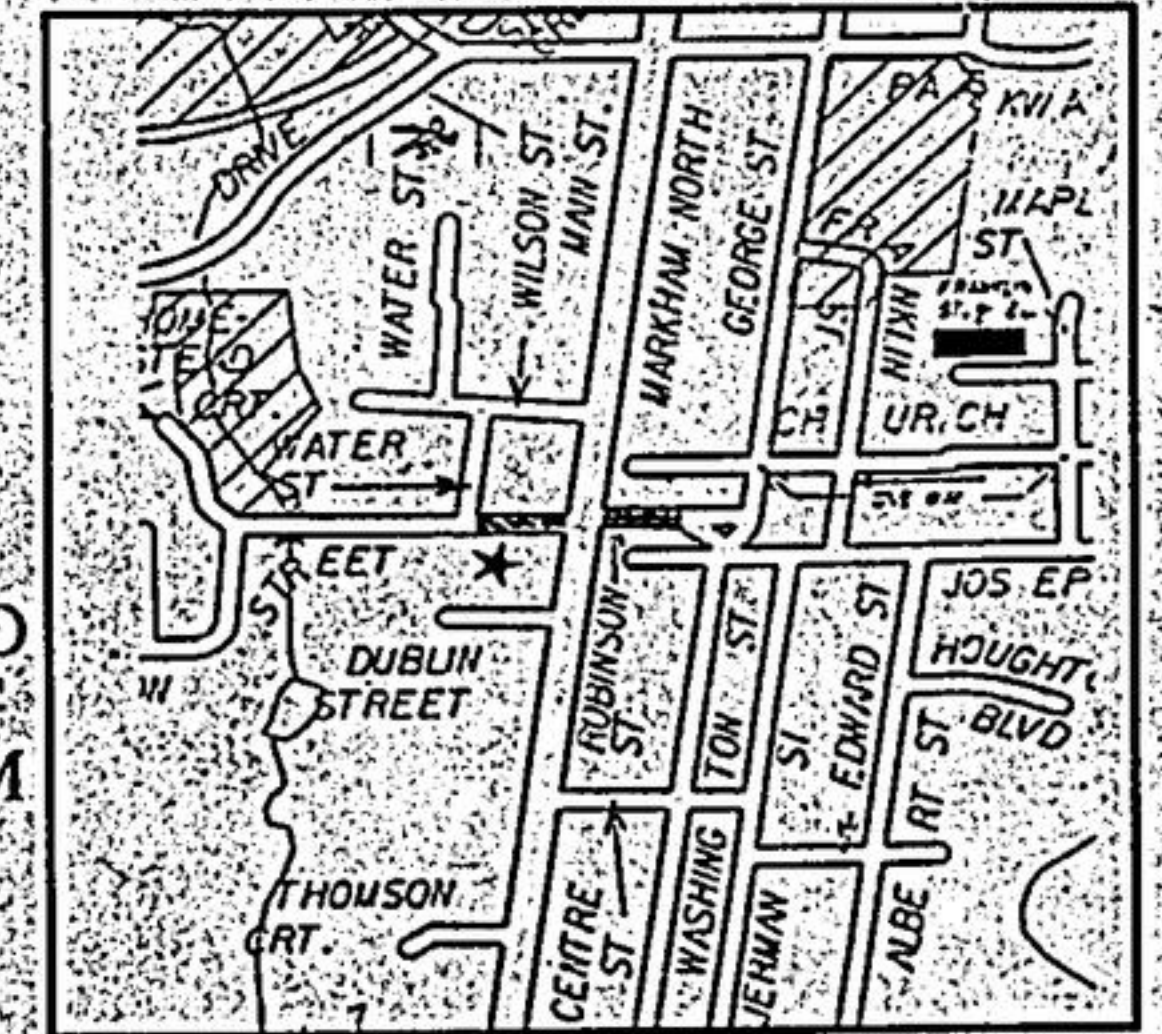
WEEKLY ROAD CLOSURE (TEMPORARY)
