Markham Concert Band will be commissioning the publication of several works composed by long time member Vern Kennedy this summer.

The band is in its second year under the direction of Diana Brault and in its 22nd year of existence.

It consists of 60 musicians, but will always welcome a new player without an audition.

Thanks to a grant by the Town of Markham Celebrate 2000 Committee, the band will incorporate several pieces performed over the years into a suite suitable for community and high school bands.

The concept behind the project is to provide bands with music by local artists to incorporate into their repertoire.

In conjunction to the project, the band is booked to perform several of Kennedy's works in concerts throughout the summer, including two or three free concerts in the park.

Kennedy has been with the band for many years while establishing himself as a vocalist, trumpeter, music arranger, composer and educator.

The kick-off of the project will be held tomorrow at 3 p.m. at Markham Theatre. The band premieres Kennedy's newest piece Thinking of You.
