The Second Instalment of the 2000 Interim Taxes are due on or before May 19, 2000

TAX PAYMENTS may be made by mail, or in person at the Town Office and at most Financial Institutions through tellers, banking machines and by telephone. Banking fees may apply. Penalty will be charged and added to your tax account at our office on payments made at the bank after the due dates. After hours tax payments may be made in the drop box at the front west entrance door of the Imperial Building (37 Sandiford Drive).

THE PENALTY charged for non-payment of 2000 taxes is one and one-quarter (1-1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.
