Business surveyed on high-speed cable

Downtown Stouffville, home to the most modern conveniences, is soon to get one more — fibre-optic cable.

Whitchurch-Stouffville Chamber of Commerce is surveying local businesses to find out how many of them need such a cable and would pay to have it installed.

"It would encourage businesses to come here," chamber president Helene Johnson said this week.

Some of the companies in town are exporters or importers with international ties and find ordinary telephone lines too slow for their high-speed communications, Johnson said. "They need higher speeds for teleconferencing down in the U.S. and all over the world."

The greater the number of businesses willing to

hook up, the lower the potential cost, she added.

The chamber wants to hear from members and also any non-member businesses which are interested, whether they are in the downtown core or not.

"We'd like their input, too," Johnson said. "This will tell us if there really is a need in the area."

The chamber is asking companies how many telephone lines they use (and what type), the speeds at which they send data and whether they are connected to the Internet.

It wants to know if they would consider upgrading to a higher speed and what they would do if they had a high-speed connection.
