Request for Proposals Employment Lands Technical Study RFP 16-00

The Town of Markham wishes to retain consultants to undertake a study comprised of servicing, transportation, environmental and land use components that will provide the technical background and overall context to support decisions relating to the designation of lands for employment use within two study areas in north and east Markham. The Employment Lands Technical Study will be undertaken in two phases:

- Phase One is intended to provide key findings, official plan policies, recommendations and implementation options respecting servicing, environmental, transportation, land use and development matters for the development of lands within the study areas for employment.
- Phase Two will build upon the background information, key findings, implementation options, recommendations and guidelines of Phase One to provide Secondary Plan(s) and further details regarding the implementation of these plans consistent with effective growth management.

The Employment Lands Technical Study (Phase One) consists of five components:

- Master Servicing Plan
- Transportation
- Environmental Management Plan
- Land Use & Development
- Project Management

The Town has invited a number of firms to submit study proposals based upon their qualifications and expertise involving engineering, transportation, environmental, land use planning, and project management. Proposals may also be submitted by other interested consultant firms.

Consultants may submit proposals for one or more of the study components. Terms of Reference for the Employment Lands Technical Study and its component studies may be obtained from the Development Services Commission, Information Counter, Unionville Entrance, Anthony Roman Centre, 101 Town Centre Boulevard, Town of Markham.
