Odds stacked against new betting parlour

While she won't lay odds on it, the co-owner of an off-track betting parlour on Markham Main Street hopes her fortunes might be changing.

Council agreed Tuesday night to open the debate to the public — it will hold a meeting June 29 to gather opinion on whether the Village Lanes plaza is the proper place for Heritage Champions.

"I see it as a good thing, but then I've probably been overly optimistic from the beginning," said a relieved Leslie Patterson, who co-owns the business with Bradford Councillor Marty Toombs.

She's facing financial ruin after Mayor Don Cousens convinced council — with little background information and no public input — to oppose the plan in January, one week before the scheduled opening.

As a result, the Ontario Racing Commission had no choice but to deny Patterson an operating licence.

Patterson is now being sued by her financial institution for close to \$100,000, telling council she was served with the papers Monday.

Patterson and Toombs have already spent \$300,000 to renovate the former banquet hall, installing 40 televisions in the restaurant.

The landlord, while realizing Patterson is caught in the middle, is out five months' rent and plans to initiate legal action to recoup those funds. Bills are coming in, suppliers have to be paid and the business has yet to open its doors.
