dent of the Markham Board of Trade and an outspoken critic of the bylaw, made a last-ditch effort to stop the bylaw.

"We have repeatedly said to councillors...there must be a full and fair process, that all stakeholders must be brought to the table to work out a compromise," she said.

"Obviously no one is listening." Council disagreed, arguing no one showed up at three information meetings held for the hospitality business.

But Burkholder said no one showed because there was no point. She said she's been asking for months for an independent mediator to facilitate discussion, claiming public meetings held to discuss the bylaw were biased.

"We're very disappointed," she said in an interview following the bylaw's

approval. "There was no discussion with the stakeholders and with such a contentious issue a compromise should have been worked out."

She predicted a number of small restaurants and pubs will be forced to close as many claim up to 90 per cent of their customers are smokers.

Markham's current bylaw calls for establishments to set aside 75 per cent of their business for non-smokers.

"They're having trouble enough conforming to the 75-25 per cent ratio now," she said. "The smaller establishments don't have the money for a designated smoking room or the space. Hotels and banquet halls have both money and space so it discriminates against the little guy."

Paul Vasilovsky, owner of Blacksmith's Bistro and the Unionville Arms, said the new regulations will defi-
