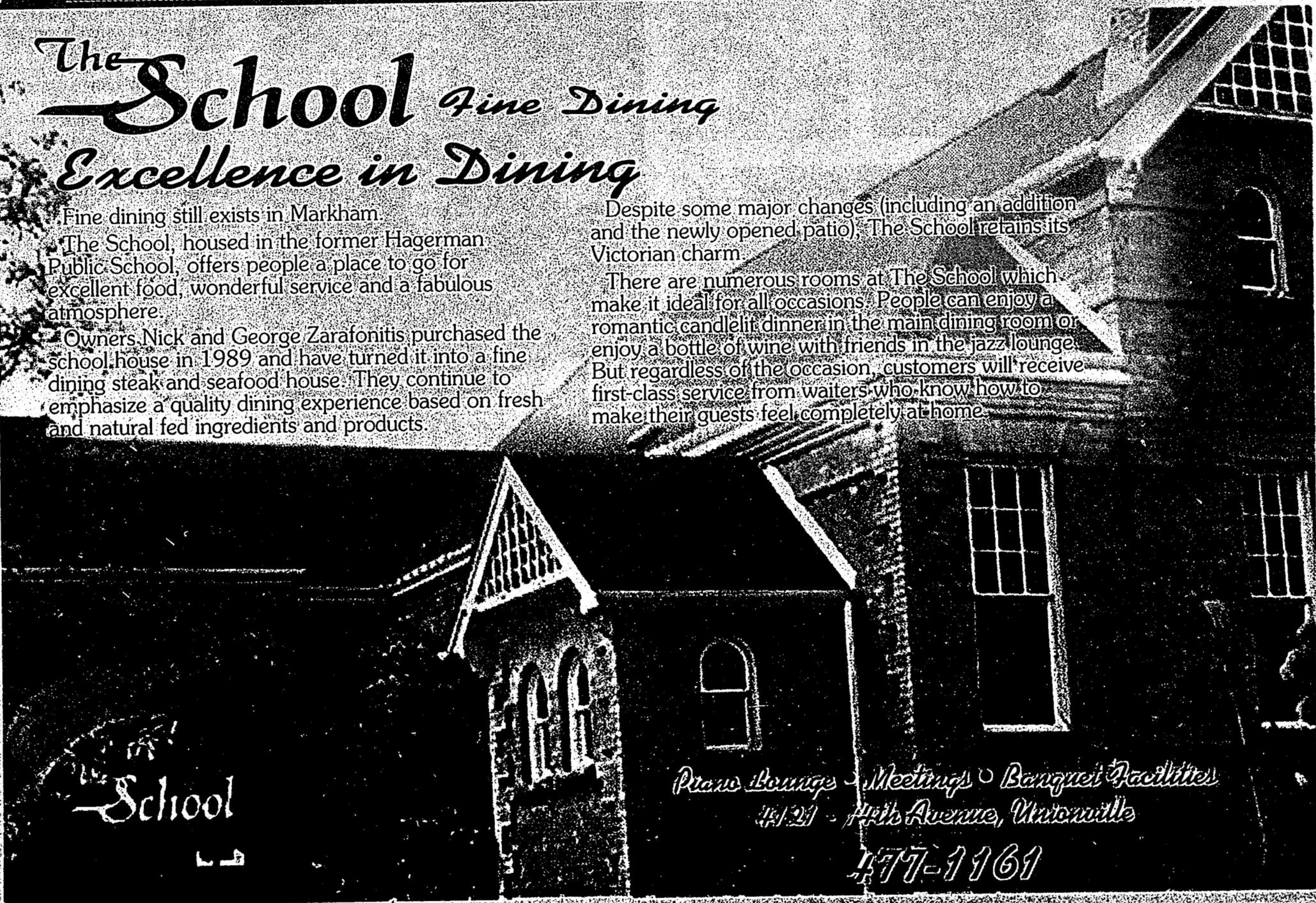
The School Fine Dining Excellence in Dining
