## Bad water watchlist doesn't wash in York

Owners on secret list criticize news article

York Region yesterday criticized a newspaper article listing local sites of well water contamination as inaccurate. Owners of those sites said there was no chance for any human exposure to harmful bacteria.

A company on the list, King Cole Ducks of Stouffville, said there was absolutely no reason for its poultry plant to have been included on the "privileged and confidential" list of "adverse water incidents" printed yesterday by the Globe and Mail.

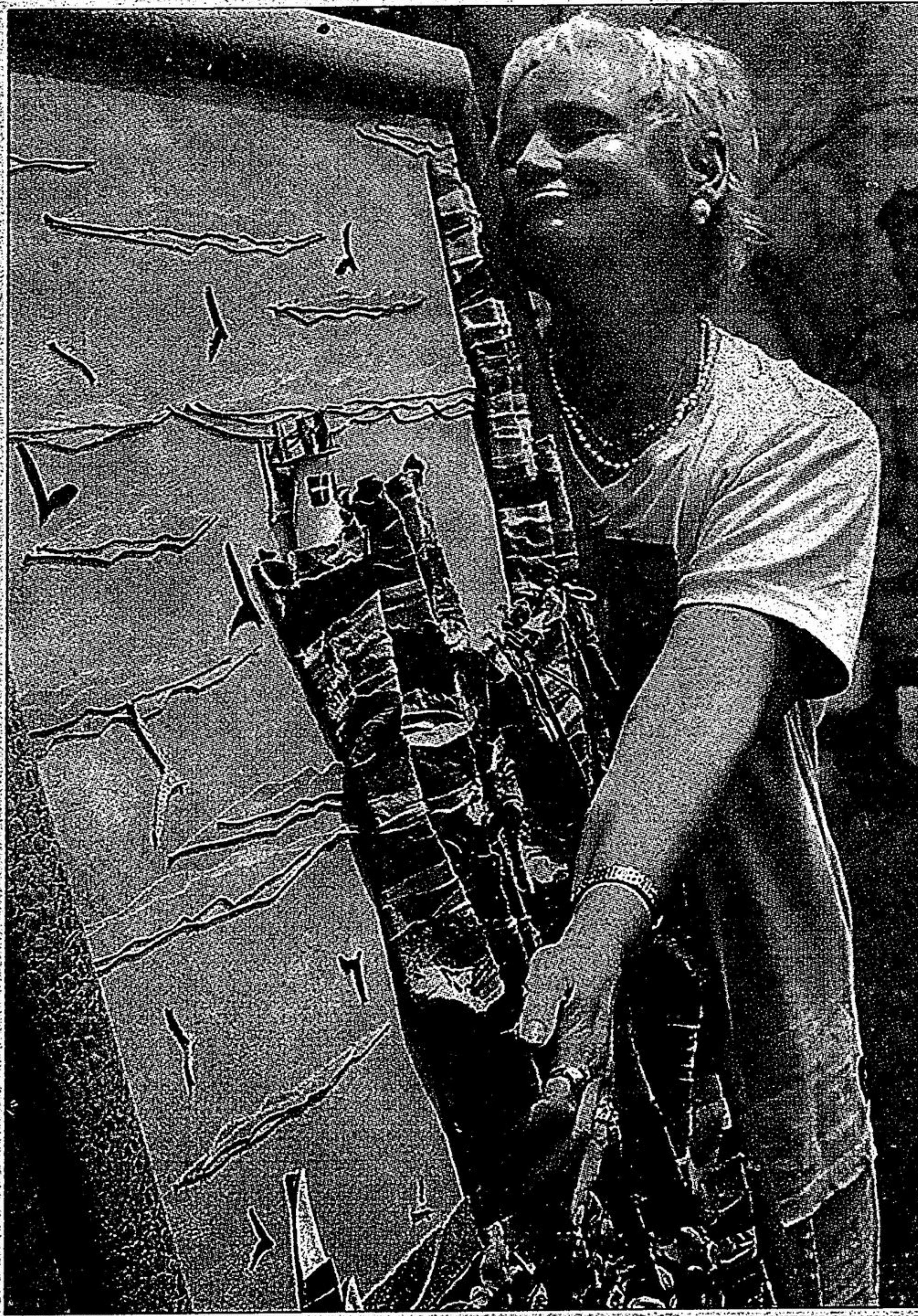
The newspaper, in presenting what it called a province-wide "confidential watchlist" from the Ontario Ministry of the Environment "failed to distinguish between municipal and private water supplies", the region said in a release.

The list of 100 so-called problem areas simply contained names of York Region municipalities — "Schomberg, Markham, Aurora, Vaughan (Thornhill)" — and specific locations, among them an Aurora golf club, the Stouffville poultry manufacturer, an East Gwillimbury public school and a pair of historic buildings in Vaughan.

The ministry did not comment on the report yesterday, but

## Racers roar to victory at Indy

Two York Region drivers win supplemental races in Toronto

Canadian racers were front and centre at the Toronto Molson Indy, including Andrew Bordin and Jonathan Macri, two York Region drivers who captured championships in Sunday's supplemental races.

Woodbridge's Bordin slipped by series leader Buddy Rice with five laps remaining on the 1.7-mile Exhibition Place street circuit and held off his challenger to win his first CART Toyota Atlantic Championship series race this year.

And, earlier in the day, Macri won his third consecutive Canadian Formula Ford 1600 race when event organizers used an infrared laser light positioned at the finish line to award the Gormley resident with the smallest margin of victory in Indy's 15-year Toronto history.

Macri was credited with a 1/1000th of a second verdict over Jean-Sebastien Bedard, while Walter Koller was 2/1000th of a second behind in third.

"I was just trying to force a mistake out of Bedard and it was a drag race right to the finish line," pointed out Macri, a Team Aim Autosport driver who leads the series, trying to claim the driver's championship in his second year on the open-wheel circuit. "But I didn't even know if I had won."

"The adrenalin was going crazy. It's defi-
