# Macri's go-karting experience pays off with checkered flag

For Jonathan Macri, 1/1000th of a second was as good as a minute at Sunday's Formula 1600 Open Wheel segment of the Molson Indy at Toronto's Exhibition Grounds.

And, just to add some extra pizzazz to his dramatic split second victory, the 18-year-old Gormley racer likened his race-winning move coming out of the final corner of the ninth and last lap, to the move used by Tom Cruise's character in the movie *Days of Thunder*.

"You make him think you're going to take him inside then you go outside."

But Macri denies Cruise and company any claims they may have to the originality of the move that gave him his third checkered flag in three outings in this year's Canadian Formula Ford Championship Series.

"It was kind of like an old go-kart move I used to do, going from the inside to the outside."

Macri had to wait until the boys manning his pit crew radio informed him of his close shave victory over second-place finisher J.S. Bedard of Quebec.

Macri was a full half lap into his post race wind down when word came through on his cockpit head set that he'd won.

"I was throwing my fist in the air and waving at the crowd," he recalled.

Not surprisingly, it was the narrowest margin of victory in 15 years for the Formula Ford series. Macri began the nine-lap race in third position in his 1990 Aero 2 racer. His run to the front of the 31-car pack was hindered when one of the leaders refused to leave the track after being black-flagged on the third lap.

"He held us up, he wouldn't let us pass. He finally left on the seventh lap."

Macri then went to work to narrow the four-car-length lead held by Bedard heading into the final lap.

His chance finally came on the final corner when his opponent stayed inside in an attempt to keep Macri from passing him.

Macri went to the outside at the last second to pull even with Bedard. He then managed to finish ahead by a hair after the two cars streaked to the finish line.

"We had a drag race for the final 300 to 400 yards. I had a better run coming out of the final corner. Being on the outside I could make a larger radius. He was trying to block me on the inside."

Obviously, Bedard didn't cruise the same go-kart tracks as Jonathan in days gone by.

Macri will be looking to make it four straight wins when he heads to Quebec for the next two races in the eight-race season series the weekend of July 29. The doubleheader has been scheduled to make up for the postponement due to rain of a race in Shannonville, Ont. last month. Then it's on to the American LeMans series at Mosport the Aug. 4 weekend. He returns to Mosport Aug. 24 for a CASCAR event.

Macri heads into the middle leg of the series with 63 points, a full 21 points ahead of his nearest competitor.

If Macri keeps this up he may be in line for a special invite so he can show Tom Cruise a few more deft racing moves.

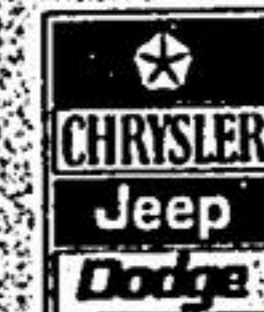
