Speed clean your home

- Put on suitable clothing for the


cleaning that you plan to do. Don't wear a dress shirt or a pair of nice pants to clean the floors and the bathrooms. Set aside cleaning clothes, and wear supportive shoes, gloves, kneepads and eye protection if necessary.

- Invest in proper tools. The average homeowner wastes far too much time trying to locate powdered cleansers, the toilet brush, cleaning towels, vacuum, etc. Arrange your tools at the start, and don't forget to include a plastic bag for trash.

- As obvious as it may sound, use both hands when cleaning. This will add to your efficiency and help to complete your work sooner. For instance, spray a mirror with one hand while wiping it down with another. Use two sponges when scrubbing counters.

- Make sure that all surfaces are clutter-free before you start cleaning. This includes counters, furniture, appliances and floors. If you leave toys, papers and other clutter on these surfaces it's more inconvenient to move them later. If you don't remove them, your cleaning job won't be thorough.

- Work in teams. Find a friend or family member with whom you can share the workload. The more people you can get involved in helping to clean, the sooner the job will get done.
