IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YORK REGION RESIDENTS ON PRIVATE WELL WATER SYSTEMS

As of Monday, September 11, 2000 private well water analysis bottles can be picked up and dropped off at the York Region Health Services Department Office at the Tannery, 465 Davis Drive, 2nd Floor, Newmarket. The Health Services Office at 22 Prospect Street will no longer be accepting well water samples or have water bottles available for sampling.

The relocation of this service is expected to improve public access to information and services. Also, Public Health Inspectors will now be on site at the new Tannery location between 8:30am and 10:00am, Monday to Friday to respond to inquiries from the public about private well water systems, interpretation of water analysis reports, well disinfection and water treatment systems.

The other locations where water sample bottles can be picked up and dropped off remain unchanged. Collection days for the water sample bottles are Tuesday and Thursday from 8:30am to 12:00pm.

The locations are as follows:

- Georgina: Georgina Civic Centre, 26557 Civic Centre Road, Keswick.
- Markham: York Region Health Services office, 4261 Highway No. 7 East, Suite 203, Unionville
- Richmond Hill: York Region Health Services office, York Central Hospital, 10 French Street, Level 1, Richmond Hill

Public Health inspectors are also available on site at the Markham and Richmond Hill locations between 8:30am to 10:00am Monday to Friday.

York Region residents on private well water systems are reminded to routinely sample their drinking water to ensure its bacteriological safety. Pending lab confirmation, if you are unsure about the bacteriological quality of your drinking water, boil water for five minutes.

HOW DO YOU CHECK THE LIST?

IT'S EASY...

If you are 18 years old or will attain the age of 18 years on or before November 13th, 2000, a Canadian Citizen, and reside in the Town at any time between September 5th, 2000 and Election Day (November 13th, 2000) or are the owner or tenant of property or the spouse or same sex partner of such owner or tenant - check the Voters' List to see if your name has been included. If your name is not included, and you are a qualified elector, you can have your name added to the list by completing the necessary application at the Clerk's Department, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, 37 Sandiford Drive, Stouffville. Likewise if there are any other corrections, omissions or deletions that should be made to the list, these too can be made by completing the necessary application at the Clerk's Department.

Residents should also check to see if their school support is correctly shown. It should be noted that you MUST BE Roman Catholic in order to be eligible to vote for the English Language Catholic District School Board Trustee and you MUST HAVE French language rights and BE Roman Catholic in order to be eligible to vote for the French Language Catholic District School Board Trustee.

Revisions to the list may be made at the Clerk's Department during the following period:

Monday to Friday, commencing Tuesday, September 5th through to Wednesday, November 8th, 2000 between the hours of 8:30am to 4:30pm.

Revisions will also be accepted at the Advance Votes being held on Saturday, November 4th (10:00am to 6:00pm), Monday, November 6th, 2000 (4:00pm to 8:00pm), Tuesday, November 7th (4:00pm to 8:00pm) and Wednesday, November 8th, 2000 (4:00pm to 8:00pm).

Voters requesting to amend the Voters' List after 8:00pm on Wednesday, November 8th, 2000, will be directed to do so at the Voting Place. Please note that all requests for amendments (including amendments to school support status) can be accommodated at the Voting Place.
