THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK EXPROPRIATION ACT NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND

IN THE MATTER OF an application by The Regional Municipality of York for approval to expropriate land described in Schedule "A" hereto, in the Town of Markham in The Regional Municipality of York, geographically in the Township of Markham in the County of York, for the purposes of the widening and reconstruction of 14th Avenue (YR 71) from Kennedy Road (YR 3) to the Canadian National Railway tracks approximately 850 metres west of Kennedy Road (YR 3), to a basic width of 32.0 metres with additional widenings at cuts, fills, water course crossings and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road with a continuous centre left-turn lane.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described in Schedule "A" hereto. Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing,

- (a) in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after the registered owner is served with the notice, or, when the registered owner is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;
- (b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.
