## AN INVITATION TO COMMENT ON A PROJECT TO CREATE A SINGLE TRANSIT SYSTEM IN YORK REGION

The Regional Municipality of York is working on a project to combine the five urban municipal transit systems and two other special needs transit services that currently operate in the communities of Markham, Vaughan, Richmond Hill, Newmarket, Aurora and in Georgina and Whitchurch-Stouffville. The end result is proposed to be a unified, region-wide transit system to serve the needs of a growing and increasingly mobile population.

Since the project is intended to deliver region-wide transit service that is responsive to the needs of the Region's residents, public comment is vital to its success.

As part of the public consultation process to date, the Region and its area municipalities have held open meetings at which input was received from residents, businesses and various stakeholder groups. Most recently, a random public poll conducted throughout the Region found that 70% of those surveyed favoured a single transit system to serve their communities.

Two further public consultation open houses are scheduled to take place prior to a final decision on the matter by York Regional Council. All interested residents and other stakeholders are encouraged to attend one of the following public consultation sessions:
