Police continue to investigate after a Markham company complained it was defrauded of thousands of dollars.

Restorx Treatment said the \$86,000 fraud dates back two years.

Kidnapping arrest

A fifth man has been arrested in connection with a bizarre kidnapping and sexual assault at Paramount Canada's Wonderland in July.

Police say a 21-year-old Mississauga woman was sexually assaulted after she was abducted from the theme park in Maple.

The men face a number of charges including sexual assault, forcible confinement, kidnapping and administering a drug.

Police say one of the men knew the woman from their high school days a few years ago.

Two knives were seized but police made no arrests. Nobody was injured.

Truck stolen

IBM, of Markham, has complained that thieves made off with a tractor trailer full of computer equipment in Vaughan last month.

The value of the Aug. 31 theft is set at \$565,000.

A 36-year-old man and a 41-year-old man were arrested but were later released unconditionally.

Domestic dispute

A 36-year-old woman was charged with assault with a weapon after a domestic dispute in Vaughan Tuesday.

Police say the dispute between a common-law couple escalated, with the woman ending up in hospital with self-inflicted knife wounds.

A 41-year-old man received minor injuries when he was hit with a shoe.

Rumble averted

A would-be rumble involving 20 youths was averted Thursday when police arrived before the fight began.

The youths, armed with knives, pipes and machetes, gathered for the fight on Yorkland Street in Richmond Hill at about 4 p.m.

The fight was averted when police cruisers arrived on the scene.

Sexual assault

A 10-year-old Vaughan boy has complained he was forced to perform sex acts on another person from Aug. 28 to Sept. 3.

The child says he was threatened with physical violence if he refused to comply.

He was not physically injured.
