Casual Classics. Tweeds with dramatic texture mix and mingle with solids. Separates so easy to wear and with amazing versatility these are the classics.

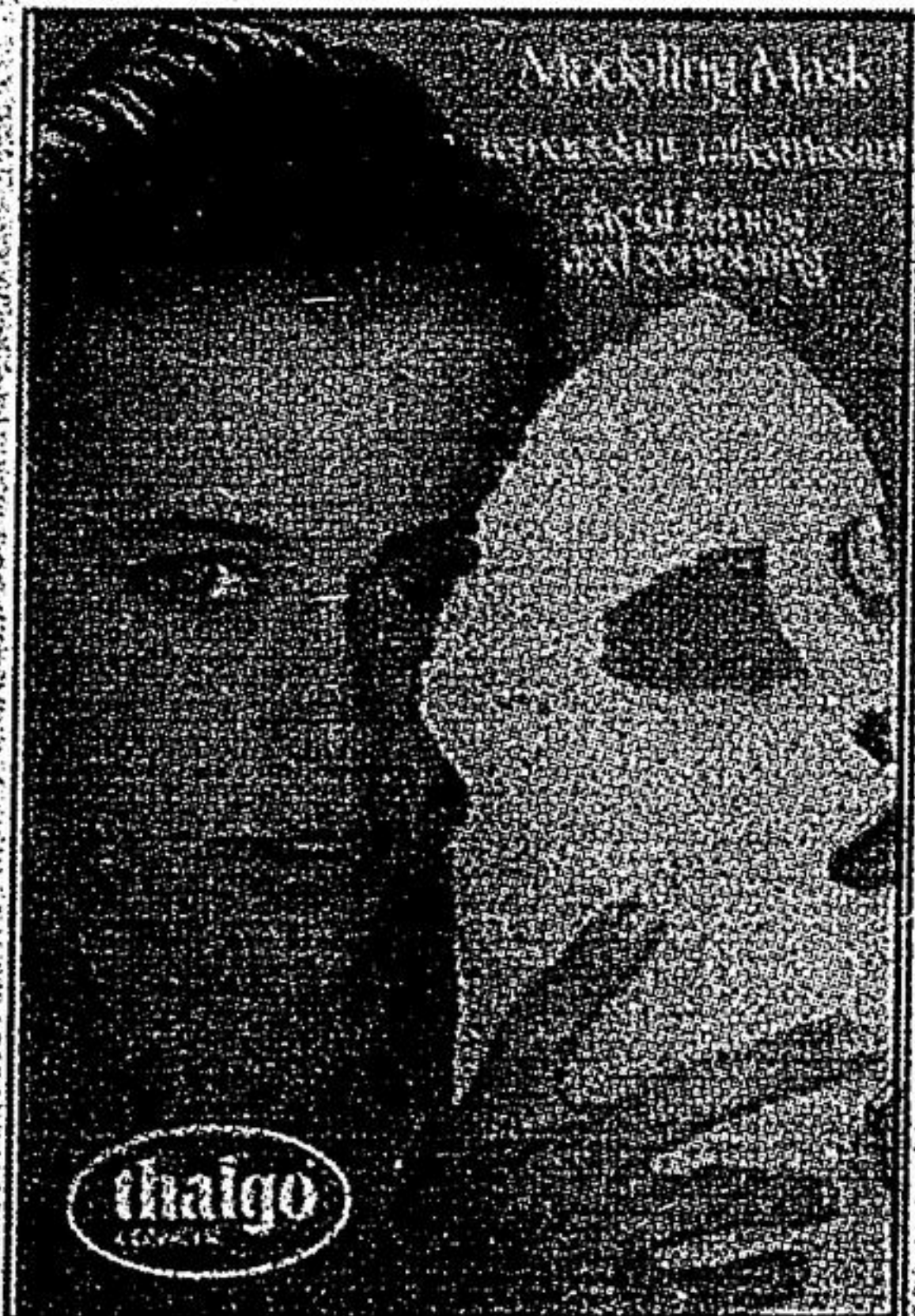

Wraps. Plaids the larger the better. Or monotoned for ultra sophistication. Fur collars to tie on have their own separate identity.

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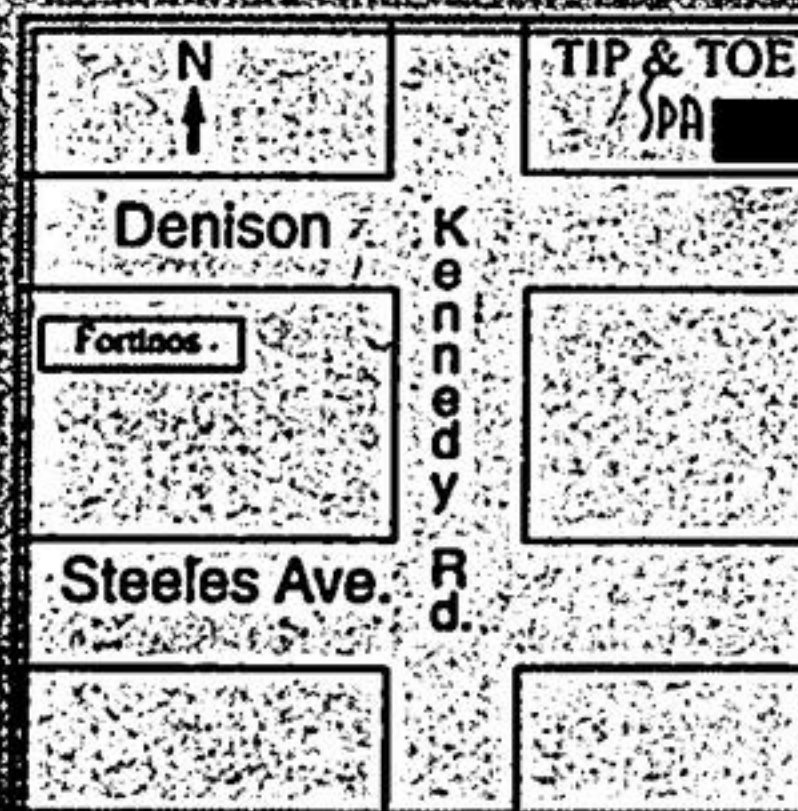
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Hose strong as never before. Fishnet, prints, colours, texture, shimmer will all add polish and finish to your look.
