Armoires have also become a classic piece of furniture for the bedroom. They come in a wide variety of solid wood and veneer finishes and can be used as multi-purpose closets for clothing and accessories, or they can serve as entertainment units for a TV, a VCR and/or a stereo.

As an added option, some retailers

even offer to stain a particular piece of furniture to your specifications. For instance, a triview mirror or landscape mirror can be stained a particular shade of blue, burgundy or green to match a dresser or night tables of the same colour.

When considering any kind of bedroom furniture, first determine how much space you have to work with. There's no sense loading up on goodies,

regardless of how great they look or what a fantastic deal you got, if you don't have the room for it. A cramped bedroom can become awfully claustrophobic in a hurry.

Finally, establish a budget before you go shopping. The price for decorating a bedroom can range from \$1,000-\$2,000 for traditional furniture sets. On the other hand, expect to pay between \$5,000 and \$10,000 or more for complete solid wood furniture,

depending on the number of pieces required. In most cases, it's worth it to spend a little extra to get furniture and accessories that you enjoy.

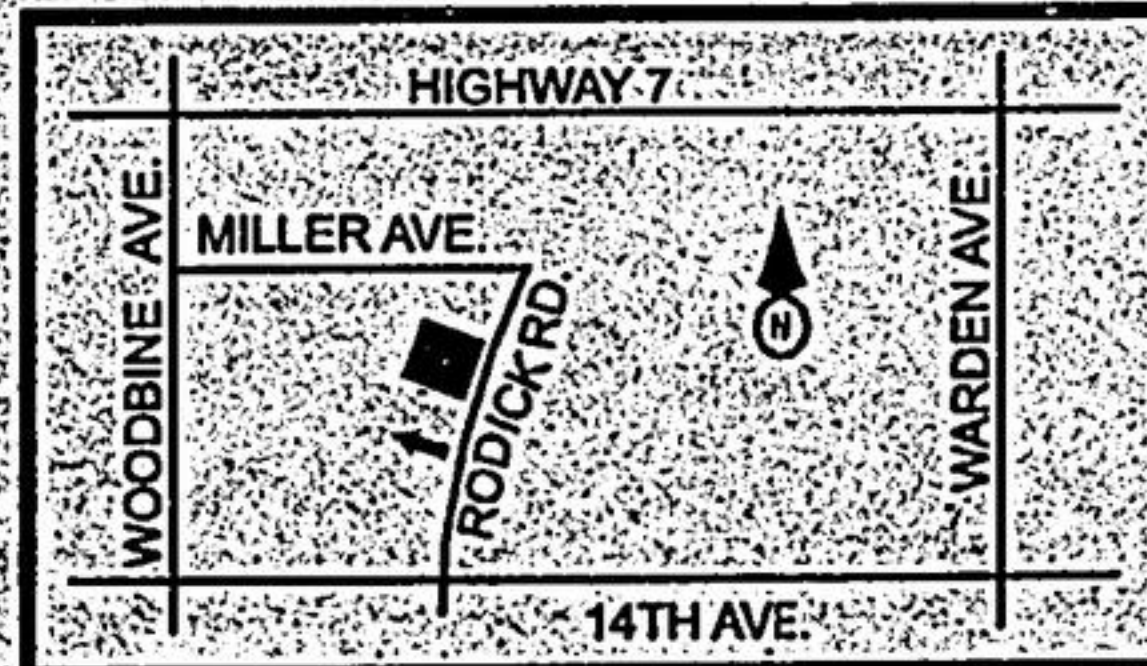


What to do:
