**Voice festival**

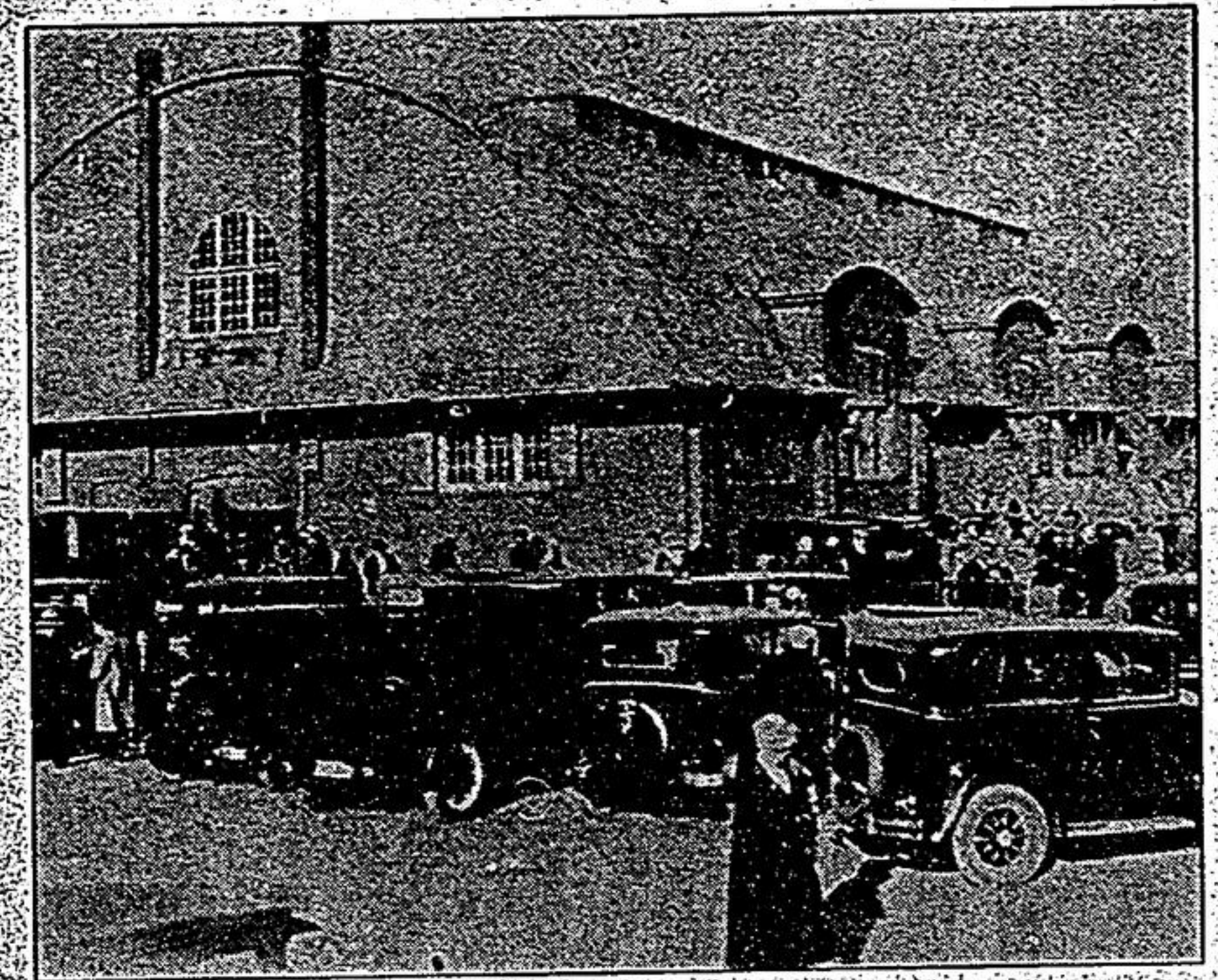

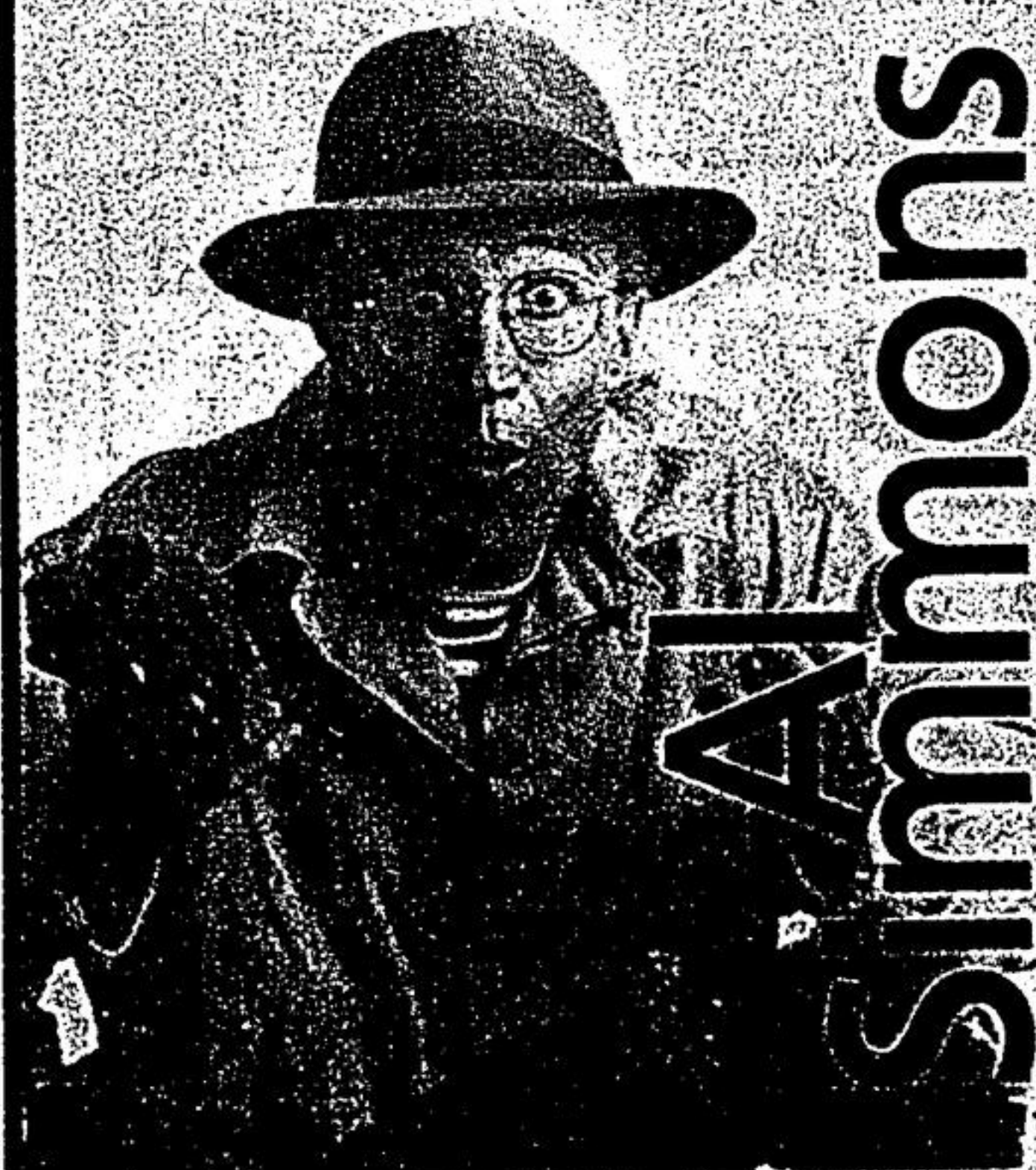
