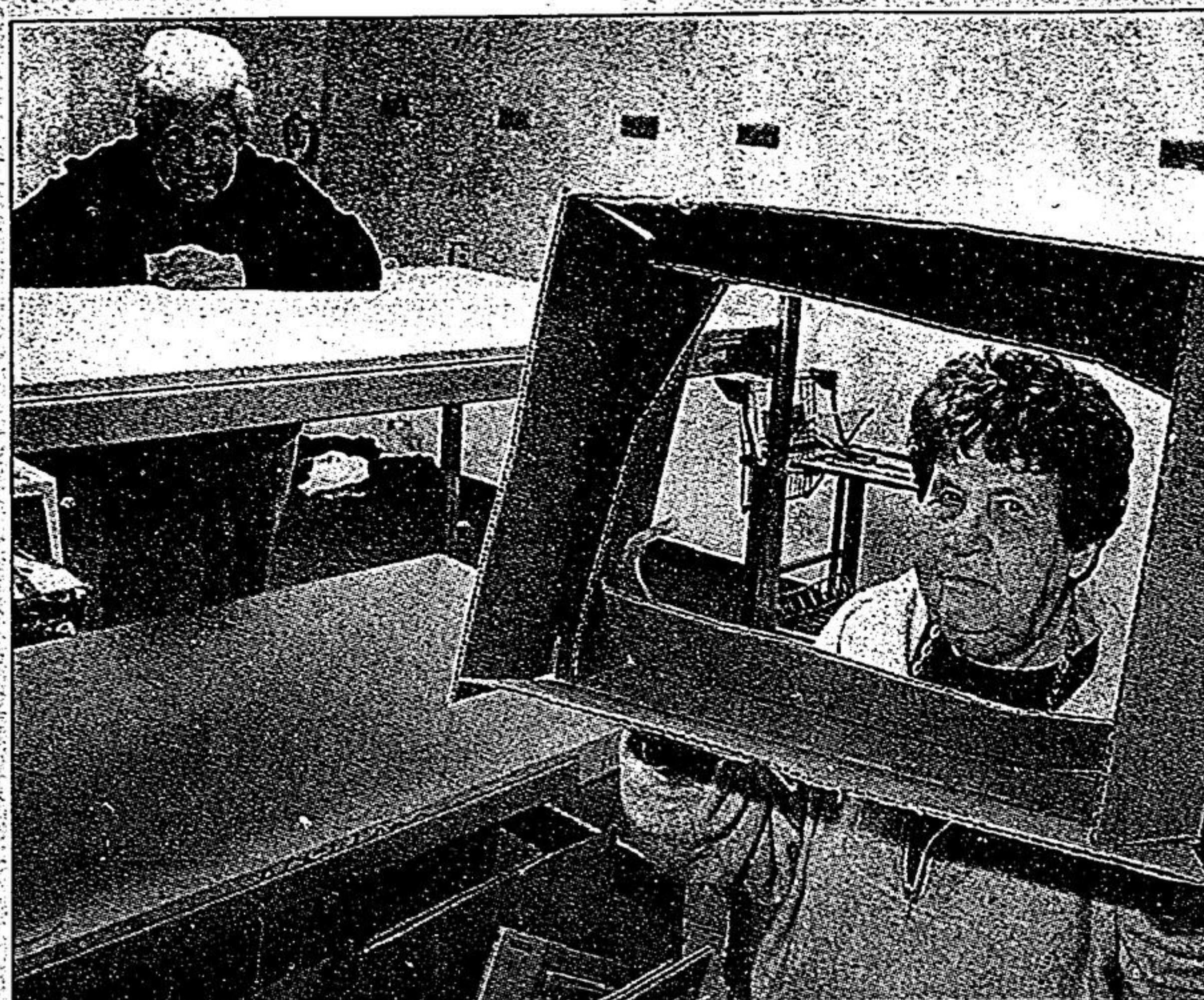

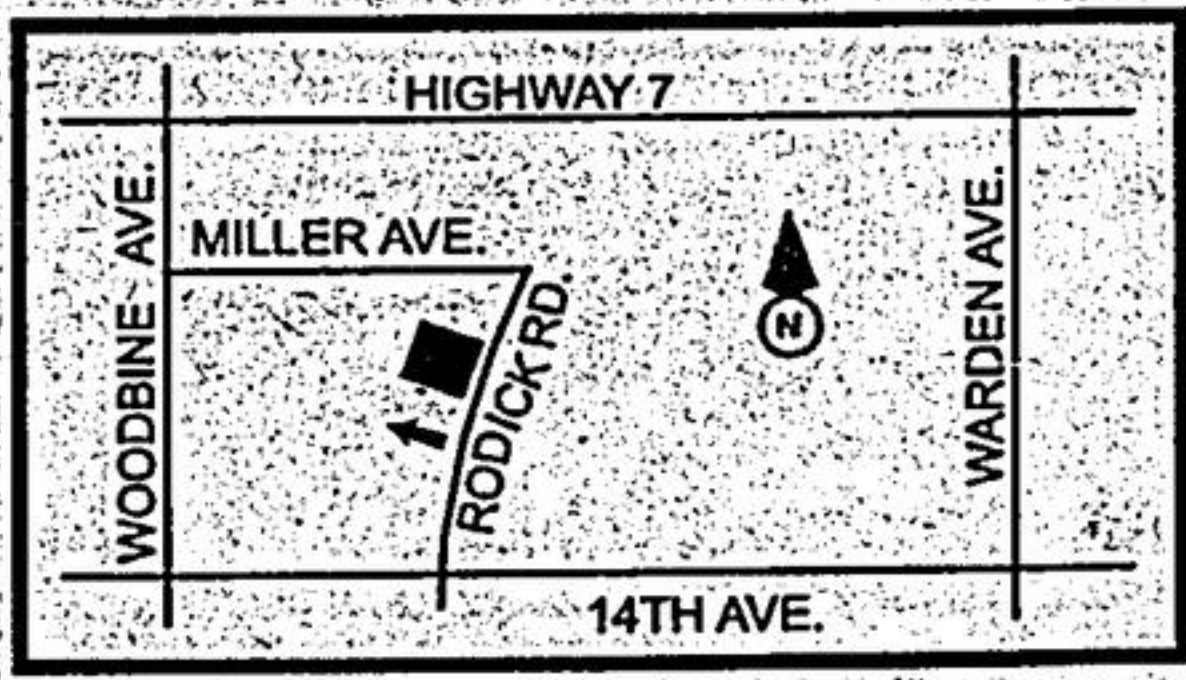

2. Make sure all materials are in original containers or contents are very well marked on containers.
Do not mix different products together. Be sure that all containers are capped. Please remember that your containers must be deposited with waste materials and are not returnable.

- Needles and syringes from household medicinal use will be accepted in rigid containers only. No other pathological wastes will be accepted.
- Motor vehicle batteries and oil filters will be accepted.
- Tires, regular garbage, scrap metal, large metal appliances, cardboard and yard waste will **not** be accepted.

Food bank is on empty

There's no food left. The Markham Food Bank is asking for help from residents as it gears up for its Thanksgiving campaign.

"We are absolutely, totally out of food," said director Sheila Spinks. "The spring drive was so poor, we're starting this

drive a week early and it will go three weeks. We need at least 20,000 pounds of food."

More than 150 local families use the food bank monthly. That's about 450 people, half of them children.

"We're not fooling here," Spinks said. "We're down to a few cases."

Brown paper bags for

the food drive will be distributed in today's Economist & Sun to Markham residents, who are urged to be generous.

Non-perishables like tinned fruit and vegetables, pasta, baby formula and jars of baby food are always necessary items.

Donations can be dropped off at any Markham fire hall.
