WATER DISTRIBUTION FLUSHING PROGRAM COMMUNITY OF STOUFFVILLE

The Public Works Department will be conducting a watermain flushing program throughout the Community of Stouffville, commencing Monday October 30th, 2000. This work will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and is expected to last until approximately Friday November 10th, 2000.

During the flushing operation discolouration of the water may occur and because of this we ask for your assistance by restricting the use of water to a minimum while the work is being conducted. Should discolouration of the water occur after the work has been completed let water run until it clears.
