Town writes parent company

**Care and Share
 eyes vacant
 Stouffville IGA**

The just closed IGA store will not be vacant for long. Whitchurch-Stouffville Mayor Wayne Emmerson is suggesting

Emmerson has sent a letter to the president of Sobies, IGA owners, asking the corporate food chain if it has specific plans for the Stouffville landmark.

Sobies does not own the building, company spokesperson Gillian Campbell explained.

"We leased at the Stouffville store so we won't be involved," she said.

There is local interest in the vacant Main Street location. On behalf of Care and Share, officials of the Mennonite Central Committee, are exploring the possibility of moving the store across the street, store manager Annette Reesor confirmed.

As well, Reesor recently made a pitch to Whitchurch-Stouffville council asking that the town consider leasing the town-owned library building to The Care and Share.

Once the new indoor pool and library complex is open in 2001, the library building, located on Main Street, beside Duffin Creek will be empty.

The Mennonite Central Committee is putting together a business plan geared to the old library. The plan will be presented to Whitchurch-Stouffville council in January. By going beyond the

library site and checking out the old IGA location, The Care and Share is "exploring its options," said Reesor.

The Care and Share opened 19 years ago and is now "bursting at the seams," said Reesor. With 75 volunteers, the store has generated \$150,000 in the past year. "It's a very busy place. We could use a lot more square footage," said Reesor.

While the former IGA

store would be a prime location, Reesor wonders about the cost. "We don't know how much renovations are needed," said Reesor.

The cost of renovation was a key factor in why the IGA store closed, said Emmerson. "It would have taken a great deal to fix it up," he said.

The Stouffville IGA hasn't been profitable for a long time. From an economic point of view, it isn't viable to keep it open, said Cameron.

The grocery store closure means some uncertainty for 22 employees. Five full time employees were offered jobs at St. Andrews IGA in Aurora, while the part-time employees are being dealt with in keeping with the terms of the Employment Standards Act, said Cameron.
