

Thirteen candidates in local federal ridings

The deadline has passed and candidates are now officially established for the federal election ridings affecting Markham and Whitchurch-Stouffville.

A total of 13 candidates are seeking the support of voters in Oak Ridges riding and Markham riding in the Nov. 27 federal election.

Markham

- Akber CHOUDHRY, Independent: Choudhry, 34, is a Woodbridge resident who runs a software consulting business out of Markham.

- Jim CONRAD, Canadian Action Party: Conrad is 70 and a Richmond Hill resident.

- Janice HAGAN, New Democratic Party: Hagan is a Markham resident, 36, married with three children.

- Jim JONES, Canadian Alliance: Jones, a former Tory, is the incumbent and a former Markham councillor.

- Bernadette MANNING, Green Party: Manning is 37, married with four children. A homemaker, the Markham resident works as an environmental activist.

- John McCALLUM, Liberal Party: McCallum is the chief economist for the Royal Bank. McCallum, who lives in Oakville, is 50.

- David SCRYMGEOUR, Progressive Conservative: Scrymgeour is single, 43, and owns several companies. He lives in Agincourt.

- Bob CALLOW, Canadian Alliance: Callow, president of Budget Propane Corp, is married with four children.

- Steven HAYLESTROM, Green Party: Haylestrom is a Stouffville businessman.

- John OOSTROM, Progressive Conservative: Oostrom, 70, is president of J.M. Oostrom International Consulting.

- Joseph THEVARKUNNEL, New Democratic Party: Thevarkunnel, 64, is a married high school teacher with three daughters.

- Mary WAN, Natural Law Party: Wan is a secretary.

- Bryon WILFERT, Liberal Party: Wilfert, 48, the current member of Parliament for Oak Ridges Riding, is married with no children.


