Fake identification used to obtain \$240,000 mortgage

A Markham man is charged with fraud after fake identification was used to secure a \$240,000 mortgage.

Police said staff at a Toronto Dominion branch in Woodbridge approved the mortgage in the name of a legitimate customer — who was not the same man who received the cash.

The money was disbursed through several bank drafts, police said.

When the bank sent a confirmation to the applicant, he called to tell them he hadn't applied for any mortgage.

The suspect wasn't seen for several months, until someone began trying to convert the drafts into US funds, arousing suspicion.

A 32-year-old faces one count of fraud and two counts of possession of property obtained by crime.

He appears in court Dec. 20.

Teen suffers cut after being threatened by knife-wielder

An 18-year-old suffered a cut to the chin after he was threatened by a man wielding a knife Wednesday in Richmond Hill.

The victim managed to throw off his

attacker and escape in the noon incident, police said.

He was walking along Harding Blvd. near Lilley Court when he was grabbed from behind and a knife placed to his throat.

As the man struggled, the attacker moved the knife to his abdomen. At that point, the victim pushed away and ran.

The suspect is described as male white, 18 or 19, wearing a navy blue cord jacket, tight blue jeans and black running shoes.

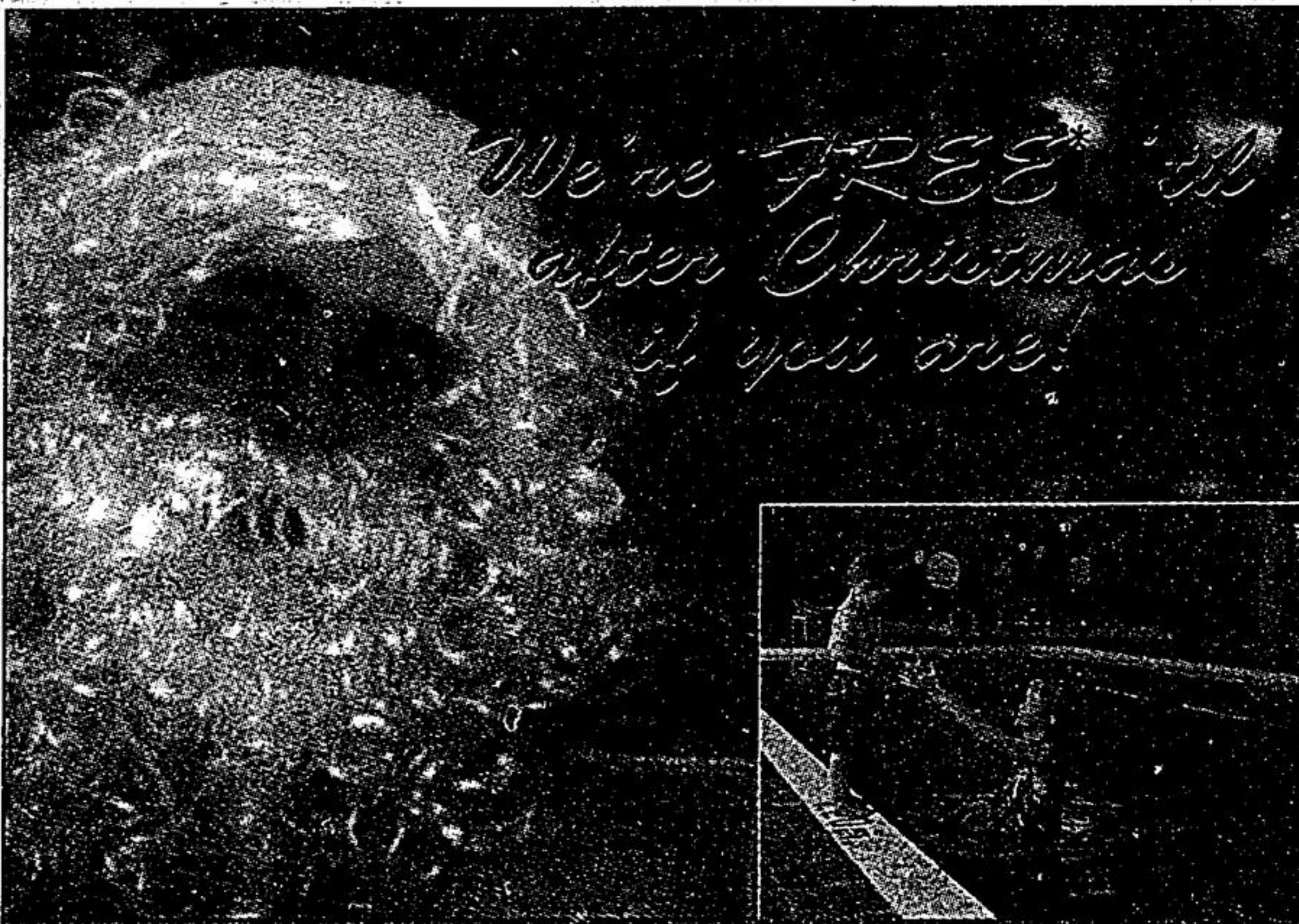
