Stouffville Festival of Lights ready to illuminate the town

The countdown is on. On Friday, December 1, the Stouffville Business Improvement Area (BIA) will host its annual Festival of Lights celebration. Organizers expect it to be one of the

biggest and most exciting events of the year. "The Festival of Lights is a dazzling spectacle and it's absolutely free," says Ruth LeBlanc, BIA Manager for downtown

Stouffville. "There will be plenty of free candy canes, donuts, hot chocolate and plenty of great prizes. We encourage everyone to drop by and check it out."

The Festival of Lights kicks off at the Clock Tower Square at 6:30 PM on Friday, December 1. The Stouffville Missionary Church will present a live nativity, featuring live actors. As a special treat for the kids, there will even be an appearance by Santa Claus.

At 7:00 PM at the Clock Tower there will be a complete roster of special guests, entertainment, and carolling with over 100 children and adults on stage. Other festive activities will include a Christmas proclamation, Mayor and Council tree lighting, Whitchurch-Highlands Children's Choir, the Stouffville Missionary Church carol sing, soloist Bill Mckee, the Ross Dixon Trio, the Magic Hill Adventure "Magic," and excitable elves.

"This is a celebration of community spirit for young and old alike," says LeBlanc. "We're all looking forward to a great evening of fun and entertainment."

Between 400 and 600 people are expected to attend this year's Festival of Lights.

The next day, Saturday, December 2, the fun and festivities continue with the arrival of the Annual Stouffville Kinsmen Santa Claus Parade. Dozens of colourful, decorated floats will proceed along Main Street to celebrate this festive time of year.
