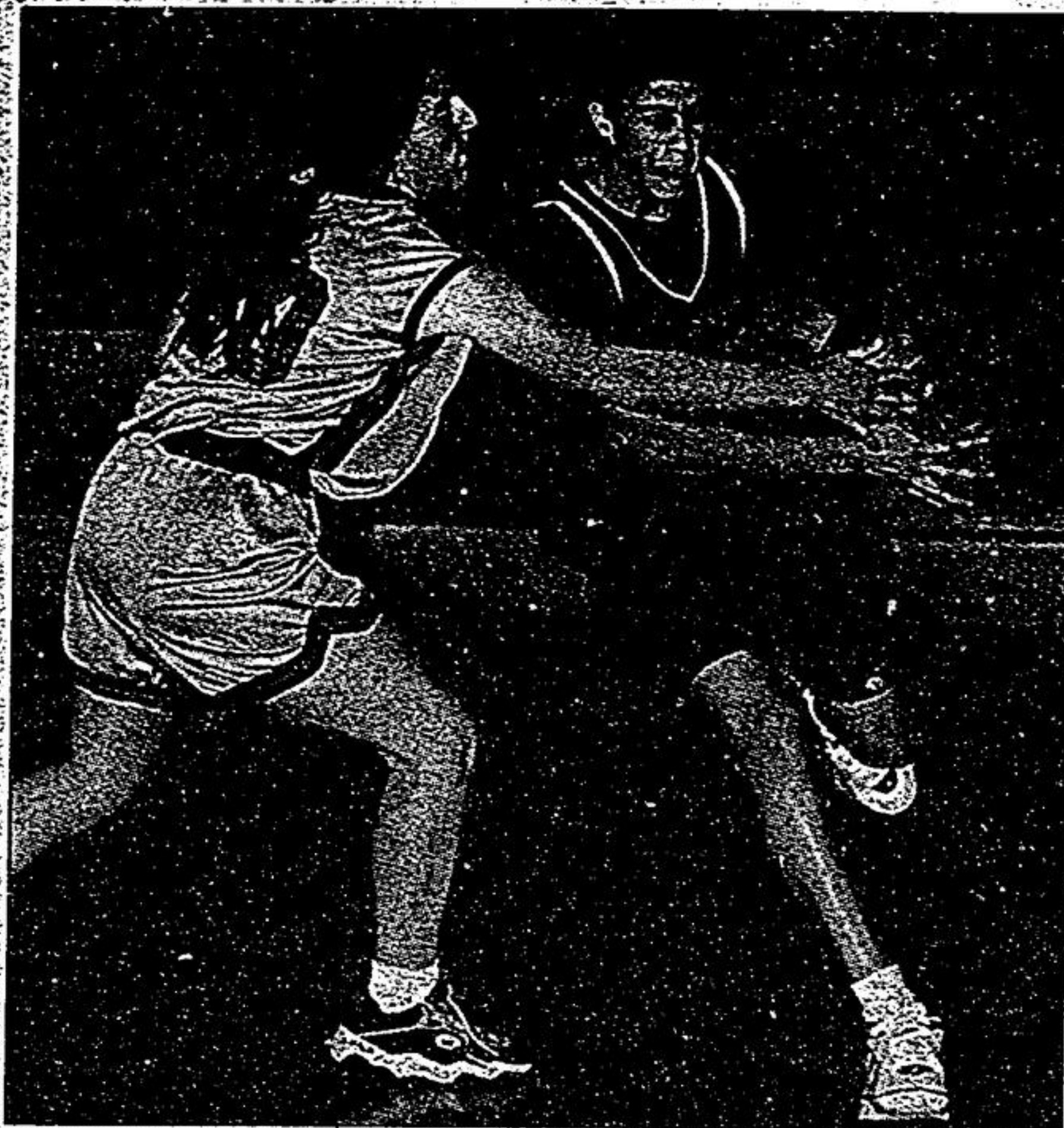

# Magic cage YRAA title

The Father Michael McGivney Academy Magic were glad to see the York Region Athletic Association elected to conduct at least one more year of midget girls basketball.

If in fact this was the final year, the Magic made the most of it in Thursday's YRAA final by capturing the title, the school's first in that sport, with a 62-31 win over St. Joan of Arc Thunder on the Bayview Secondary School hardwood floor in Richmond Hill.

The Magic also finished its season with an unblemished 14-0 record.

"I heard they (YRAA) were supposed to do away with (a midget league) this year," said Magic head coach Belinda Lynn. "But they didn't and we're glad."

Magic point guard and captain Reem Rekeh led all scorers with 22 points while centre Kimberly Lee added 13 and guards Michelle Ngo and Viola Cheung each had 12.

Lynn felt her club's ability to carry out their gameplan and play to their potential was the key to winning the title.

"The girls followed the plays that we taught them," said Lynn. "Our guards are strong ballhandlers and our front line got the rebounds on the offensive and defensive ends. All around, everyone did a good job."

Lynn and co-coach Michelle Bedard had an inclination the team would be competitive when they began tryouts in September.

"We thought we'd do okay," Lynn recalled. "But after the first couple of games we thought we'd be in the hunt for the title."

As for next season, Lynn expects the team will move into the junior ranks and anticipates good things for them down the road.

"They still have a lot to develop. But they're a skilled group and dedicated."

## YONGE STREET CORRIDOR TRANSITWAY STUDY (PREPARATION OF TERMS OF REFERENCE / NEEDS AND JUSTIFICATION)

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION CENTRES

York Region has commenced a study of the Yonge Street Corridor Transitway in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Assessment (EA) Act. The first step is to prepare Terms of Reference (this study) for the follow-on individual environmental assessment, in consultation with the public and technical agencies for submission to the Ministry of the Environment for review and approval.

The assessment of future travel demands has confirmed the future need for a North-South Rapid Transit Facility. Preliminary study findings indicate that, in general, Bus Rapid Transit is the preferred technology. The following "planning" options have been identified:

- "No-Build"
- North-South Rapid Transit Facility in one of the following corridors:
  - Yonge Corridor
  - Hwy. 400 Corridor
  - Hwy. 404 Corridor

### Public Consultation Centres

The first round of consultation centres is scheduled as follows. The purpose is to obtain public input about the preliminary study findings and to receive comments about how to get the public involved in the future. Anyone with an interest in the study is urged to attend and participate.
