

# Shooter tops U.S. loop

Boston Bruins head coach Mike Keenan could not do it, nor could Ottawa Senators' forward Eric Lacroix or former Toronto Maple Leafs and San Jose Sharks' forward Jamie Baker.

What the three former St. Lawrence University graduates failed to do, but Mike Gellard did this year, was to become the first member of the Saints hockey team to win the Eastern College Athletic Conference regular season scoring title.

The 22-year-old Markham resident, who is in his senior year at the Canton, New York, school, accomplished the feat after amassing 12 goals and 28 assists in 22 ECAC contests this season while toiling on a line with centre Erik Anderson and right winger Al Fyfe. In 33 contests overall, Gellard tallied 18 goals and 33 assists.

"Personally, I'm happy with what's happened this year," said Gellard, who played junior hockey in Thornhill. "Things just fell into place."

"My goal was to finish maybe in the top three or five in scoring."

In explaining his success, Gellard was quick to credit his linemates in Anderson and Fyfe. The trio, who are all in their senior year, were just

assembled as a line this season.

"The three of us clicked all year long," Gellard cited. "Things have worked out great for all of us."

Gellard also said his mother, Mary, helped him improve his psychological approach to the game.

"Being a curling coach, my mom got me in the right mental state of mind," he cited.

Gellard acknowledged some pressure was placed on him after reading about his potential achievement in a local newspaper with just two weeks left in the season.

"You've got to try and forget about it, but at the same time you're thinking of it. But it means a lot to the school and myself. It's a great honour."

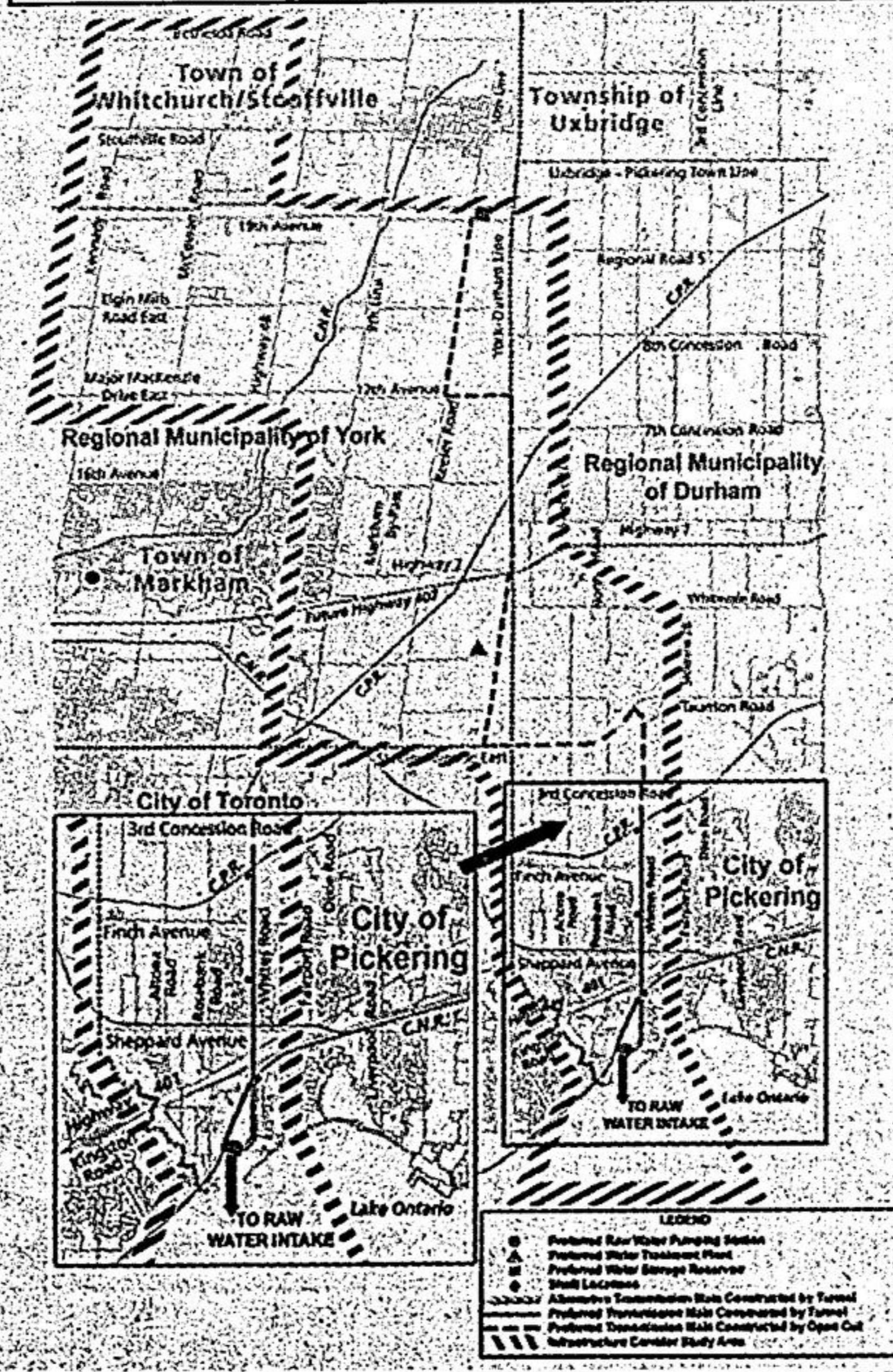


## AN INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED YORK REGION LAKE ONTARIO WATER SUPPLY VIA DURHAM WEST (PICKERING)

### Subsection 6.3 of the Environmental Assessment Act - Public Notice of Submission

An Environmental Assessment (EA) has been submitted to the Ministry of the Environment by the Regional Municipality of York for the undertaking, the Lake Ontario Water Supply via Durham West project. The EA was carried out in accordance with the study's Terms of Reference approved by the Ministry of the Environment on April 30, 1999. The EA Report was prepared by the Regional Municipality of York to obtain acceptance and approval under the *Environmental Assessment Act* (EA Act) to construct a new water supply from Lake Ontario that will include a raw water intake and pumping station in the City of Pickering, a water treatment plant in the Town of Markham, and a water storage reservoir in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville. The proposed undertaking is required to support anticipated growth in York Region as approved in its Official Plan.
