

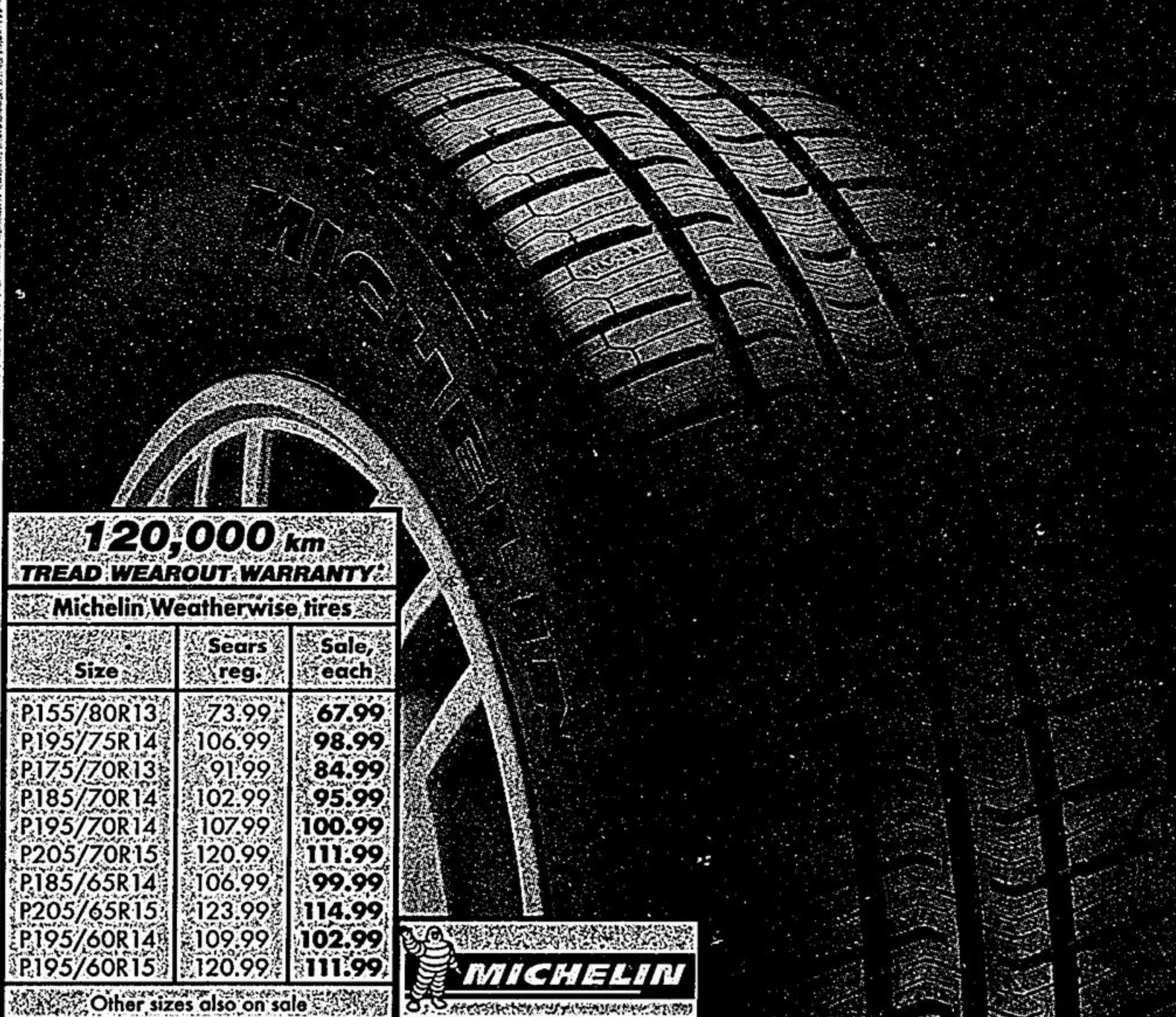

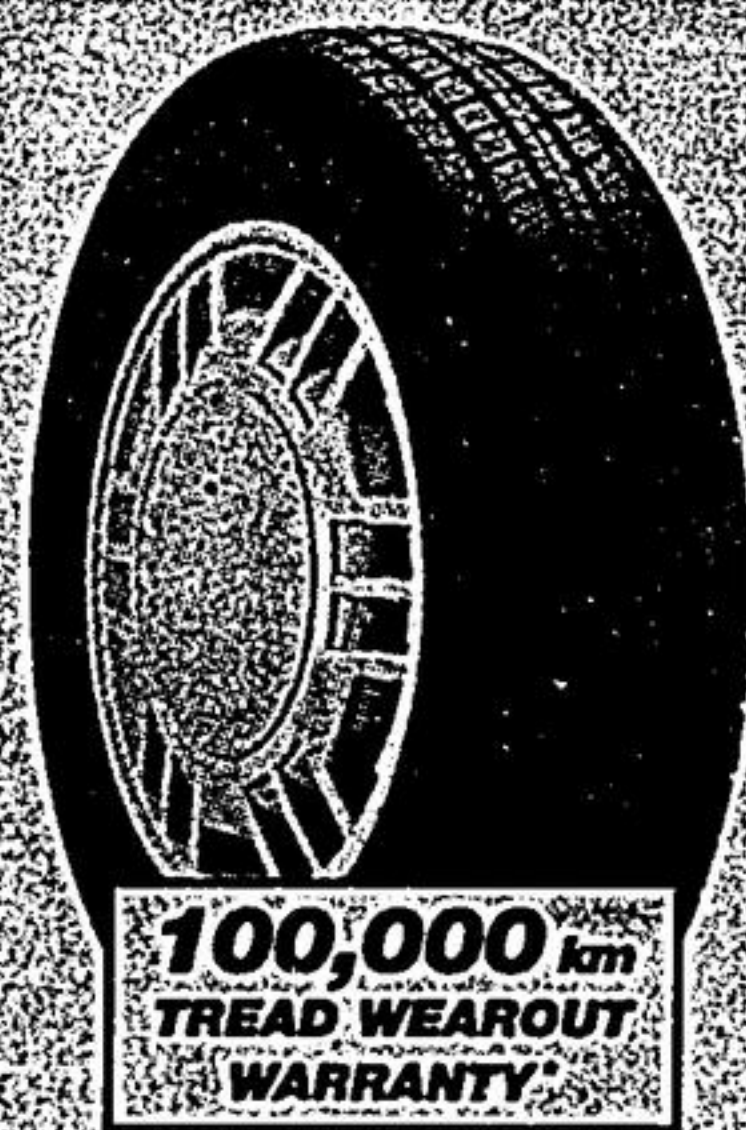

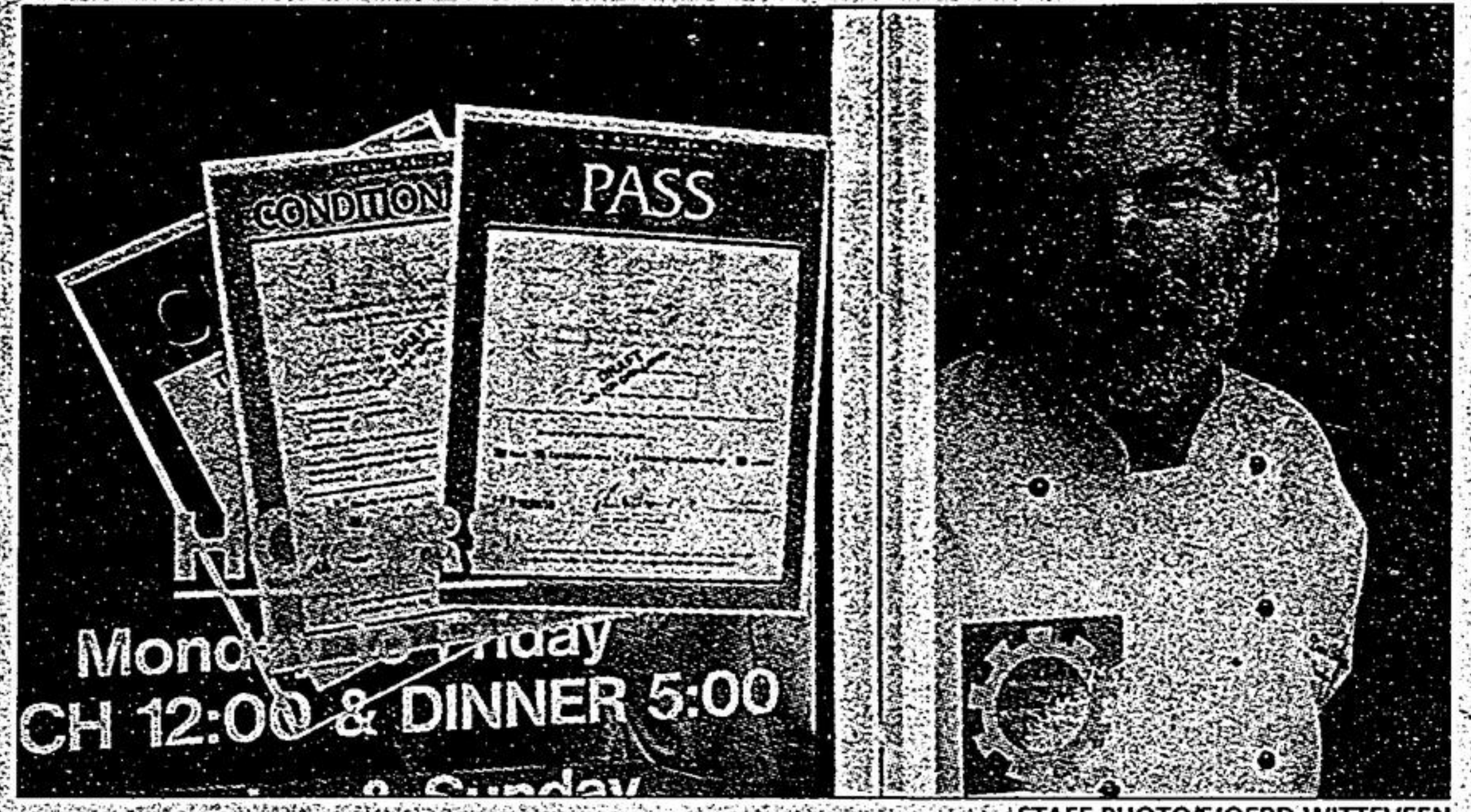

teenagers holding down their first jobs at fast-food restaurants

He also said restaurants that continue to fail health inspections should face hefty fines or permanent closure.

"Don't let a few bad apples give all restaurants a bad name," he said.

He said customers' recommendations to family and friends is more persuasive than a rating system.

"Signs outside your restaurant are insulting. Whether it's a pat on the head or 'You've been a naughty boy and can improve' or 'You've been a really bad boy and should shut down,' I think it's kind

of like a personal assault on the whole industry."

At the moment, the region has no authority to implement a rating system because the responsibility for licensing restaurants lies with local municipalities.

But regional councillors are debating a system to let customers know a restaurant's standards before they walk through the front door.

Regional chairperson Bill Fisch has argued a pass-fail system isn't good enough because it would lead customers to think an eatery that passed had been given a completely clean bill of health when it actually had deficiencies.
