

# New twist on time capsule

The big drawback with your average time capsule is that once it's filled, it's sealed up for about 100 years or so.

But a group of artists, parents, teachers and students in Mount Albert are creating a new interactive type of time capsule that is the next best thing to a revolving door — it will be opened every year by a new class of students at Mount Albert Public School.

And it is the world's only time capsule shaped like a giant horse — a 7-1/2-foot tall, 3,000-pound iron horse containing

built-in drawers for kids and community members to leave stories for future generations.

The iron horse will be mounted on a section of rails that once ran through the town and was installed in front of the school this May. The concept, said team member Jenny Carver, pulls together Mount Albert's history as a railway town, while also underlining the significance of the horse to the history of the area.

## THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK EXPROPRIATIONS ACT NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND

IN THE MATTER OF an application by The Regional Municipality of York for approval to expropriate land described in Schedule "A" hereto, in the Towns of Markham and Whitchurch-Stouffville in The Regional Municipality of York, for the purposes of the widening and reconstruction of Ninth Line (YR 69) from the proposed Highway 407 to Main Street, Stouffville, to a basic width of 36.0 metres with additional widenings at cuts, fills, watercourse crossings and intersections, to provide:

- (a) a basic four lane road from proposed Highway 407 to Major Mackenzie Drive East (YR 25);
- (b) a basic two lane road from Major Mackenzie Drive East (YR 25) to Main Street, Stouffville, with a continuous centre left-turn lane within Stouffville;
- (c) a basic four lane road on Main Street between Ninth Line (YR 69) south of Main Street and Ninth Line (YR 69) north of Main Street; and
- (d) left-turn and right-turn lanes at intersections.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described in Schedule "A" hereto. Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing,

- (a) in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after the registered owner is served with the notice, or, when the registered owner is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;
- (b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.
