Teeing off on the Markham-Stouffville golf season

Late opening of local courses didn't dampen golfers' enthusiasm

Good bye winter, hello spring.

To any local golfing enthusiast, those are words are welcomed with open arms.

And to be quite frank, spring's arrival couldn't come soon enough considering that many golf courses last year opened their facilities a week or two earlier than usual.

Mike Begley, a club pro at Parkview Golf Club in Markham, recalled their 36-hole public facility opened March 27 last year. This year, the 18-hole upper course was open for business April 7 while the 18-hole lower course's opening was delayed due to wet grounds in the Rouge River valley and did not open until last Saturday.

"The weather definitely played a role in our course opening later this year," he confirmed. "There was more snow cover this year."

While the later opening cut into some business days, Begley said it hasn't dampened the spirits of those who take to the links.

"People's recreation time has become more valuable and golf is so popular. Last Sunday (April 8) we had 25-degree Celsius weather and we were swamped with people," he recalled.

Old Man Winter's stubbornness to make an early exit also played a bit of havoc with Whitchurch-Stouffville's public courses.

"Last year we opened Rolling Hills on March 8 and Gormley Green on March 12," cited John Finlayson, head pro at both facilities.

But in looking over the last 15 years, Finlayson noted a regular start up time is traditionally around the first of April to the middle of the month. Despite the late opening, Finlayson said golfers will make an effort to make up for any lost days.

"People might think we're behind the eight ball in starting late this year. But we're not. People will play golf and they'll play the same amount. They'll just do it in a shorter period of
