

# Roadside artists head for 'gallery'

John Roberts and the Roadside Painters will be holding an art exhibition of paintings and tapestries in Stouffville's old municipal building on the weekend of May 5 and 6.

Almost 40 works by about a dozen members of the Roadside Painters will be on display, including tapestries by local resident Janine Zeck. Many of the works portray scenes in and around Whitchurch-Stouffville and will be displayed in the old council chambers.

Artists John Roberts and Ron Brown have been rent-

ing studio space in the old building from the Clock Tower Theatre Association for the past two months. The association which hopes to turn the historic building into a theatre facility, leases the building from the town for \$1 per year.

Twenty-five per cent of all sales from the show will be donated to the Clock Tower Theatre Association.

The opening reception for the exhibition is from 2 to 4 p.m. on Saturday, May 5. The show continues the next day, Sunday, May 6 from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and 2 to 5 p.m.

## THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK PROPOSES TO PASS A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING:

### 1. WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION OF MAJOR MACKENZIE DRIVE EAST - TOWN OF MARKHAM

- (a) the widening and reconstruction of Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) from Highway 48 to Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8) in the Town of Markham to a basic width of 36.0 metres. Additional widening will be required at cuts, fills, watercourse crossings and intersections, to provide a basic four lane road and protect for a future six lane road with left-turn and right-turn lanes at intersections and the jog elimination at the intersection of Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Highway 48;
- (b) the adjustments to existing traffic control signals and associated illumination to accommodate the proposed revisions to the road layout at the intersections of Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8), Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65), Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and William Berczy Boulevard, Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Ridgcrest Road, and Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Highway 48;
- (c) the provision for future traffic control signals at the intersection of Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25) and Stonebridge Drive;
- (d) the upgrade of the existing illumination at all the intersections within the project limits;
- (e) the carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and
- (f) the acquisition of the necessary lands and interest in lands for the works described above.

Pursuant to section 300 of the *Municipal Act*, the Transportation and Works Committee of the Regional Council will, at its meeting to be held at 9:00 a.m. on the 30th day of May, 2001 in Committee Room "A" at the Regional Administrative Building located at 17250 Yonge Street, Newmarket, hear any person who claims his/her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. Anyone wishing to be heard is requested to advise the Office of the Regional Clerk, attention Elma Stevenson (telephone 830-4444 or 731-0201, ext. 1303). If any party entitled to be heard does not attend at the hearing, the Committee may proceed in his/her absence and he/she will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

The proposed by-law and plans showing the proposed works may be inspected at the office of Paul Jankowski, Director, Design and Construction Branch, at the Transportation and Works Department located at the Regional Administrative Building, at 17250 Yonge Street, Newmarket (telephone 895-1200 or 764-6345, ext. 5088).
