# Made-in-York Region law will protect kids

If all goes as planned today, the Queen's Park spotlight will be on a made-in-York Region law.

When Thornhill MPP Tina Molinari presents a private member's bill requesting new legislation to protect children, sitting in the public gallery will be Paul and Laurie Hader.

The Aurora couple have lobbied hard to persuade the province to make it mandatory for children to wear helmets and proper boots while horseback riding. Two years ago, their 10-year-old daughter Elizabeth was dragged to her death after falling from a horse. The Haders and their three children were on a Sunday outing at a Stouffville riding ranch when they witnessed the tragedy.

Some deaths are more pointless than others. Some are more preventable and some effect people more. This was one of those deaths.

When Elizabeth's foot became stuck in the stirrup, she was not wearing proper footwear. When Elizabeth hit her head on a rock, she was not wearing a helmet. Would proper footwear or a helmet have saved Elizabeth? No one knows for sure. But common sense dictates that protective gear might have made the difference.

While protective gear is mandatory for kids riding bicycles and motorcycles, nothing was in place to cover horseback riding. That's expected to change today. Molinari anticipates unanimous support from all political parties.

One thing is certain: Elizabeth Hader did not die in vain. Through the efforts of

her parents and the support of former Aurora councillor Phyllis Morris, the province-wide helmet and footwear law, if adopted, will save lives.

Before taking the issue to Queen's Park, the Haders and Morris convinced six out of nine York Region municipalities to adopt a helmet and footgear bylaw for riding establishments.

East Gwillimbury, King Township and Vaughan did not comply with the Hader's request. Instead, the makers and shakers in the three municipalities opted to wait until the province did something. In other words, it's called, "over to you, jack". It's a good game if you can get away with it.

Some argue that putting a law in place is overkill and that the horse-riding industry should be allowed to continue policing itself. Since the horse community has a dead child on its hands, one would think a few heads would bow. The fact is, a \$75 helmet and a \$75 pair of boots were not made available to protect Elizabeth. The government had no choice but to step in.

A while ago, Laurie Hader noted that before Elizabeth's death, she never thought she'd have to try to change laws in Ontario. "But I do it for my daughter," said Laurie.
