Shoppe has outgrown its present location on Main Street, one block east of the library site.

"After 20 years in business, we're jammed up" at the present location, said Hogg. "We're crammed. We need more space."

The library is a suitable spot for such a store, said Hogg.

"It's large, wheelchair and baby stroller accessible. It's a better environment for our customers and for our volunteers," he pointed out.

The Care and Share Shoppe is part of

a network of 14 thrift shops in Ontario owned by the MCCO. Run by volunteers with all items donated, the thrift shops are a non-profit marketing program, an international relief organization which works in Canada and globally among people suffering from poverty, conflict, oppression and natural disaster, said Hogg. The MCCO has 1,500 workers in 58 countries.

Once the terms of the lease are determined and the deal is signed and renovation work completed, officials of the Care and Share would be ready to start packing in preparation for the move. "It would depend on when the library is

vacant," said Hogg.

All local library services will be part of the \$7.5-million all-purpose complex being built at Memorial Park South. A

Sept. 8 opening is set for the complex.

Instead of selling the old library, the town opted to keep the building and offered it on a lease agreement.


