appease everyone.

"I'd like to say we always find a perfect match, but these decisions are system-wide and there are a lot of schools to think about. It's a massive puzzle to put together," he said.

"We always say 'here's why we picked this person, here's where he fits the characteristics, here's where he misses' and how we're going to deal with it."

"Sometimes the vice-principal has some of the qualities, sometimes we talk to the person and tell them what's important to the community," he said.

"Ultimately the trustees, the elected officials are the ones that have the responsibility for the final decision."

Thurston added while some parents want a say in every decision taken by a school, most parents just want to be informed and have the opportunity to provide input on issues they believe are important.

It's something principals themselves think is worthwhile, said Rick Victor, president of the Ontario Principals' Council.

"It's important parents have a say in who is coming into their school. In an arts-oriented school, parents want a

principal with strong experience in the arts. Or science and math, or someone who is community-oriented or who has good communication skills," Victor said.

"Or they can see what they're missing and try to find someone with those strengths."

"It gives boards a better idea in how to distribute people through the board and we support that."
