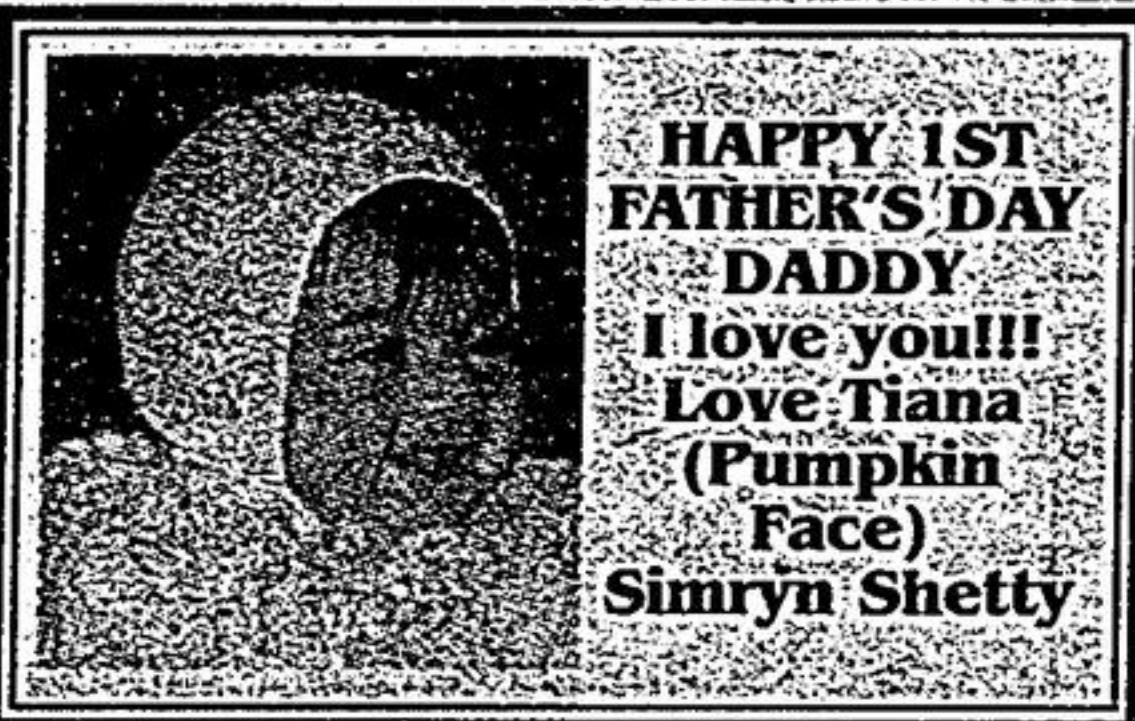

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST P-01-41

Submission Requirements The Regional Municipality of York and The Regional Municipality of Durham are seeking Expressions of Interest from Project Management Professionals (PMP) to provide Total Project Management Services (TPM) for the implementation of process optimization works at the Duffin Creek Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP) in Durham Region.

The Duffin Creek WPCP is a 364,000m3/d (80 MIGD), conventional activated sludge facility that provides treatment for wastewater from the Regional Municipalities of York and Durham. The proposed project is the result of a capacity optimization study completed in October 2000 which identified capital works required to upgrade the liquid train and biosolids treatment to increase plant capacity to 420,000m3/d (92.5 MIGD). A copy of the Optimization and Capacity Assessment Study of the Duffin Creek WPCP prepared by XCG Consultants, can be viewed at the Region of York, Supplies and Services Offices. The major upgrades consist of: i) Retrofit Aeration Facilities to Plug Flow Reactor with Fine Bubble Aeration ii) Clarifier Upgrades iii) Modifications to Chlorine Disinfection System iv) Retrofit Existing Secondary Digester into Boisolids Storage Tank v) Incineration Systems Upgrades

The works are to be completed no later than spring 2005. The estimated capital cost of the works is \$34M. This assignment is for project management services only. Technical aspects of the project (pre-design, detail design and preparation of the contract documents) will be carried out by the Engineering Consultant who will be short-listed by the Region under the EOI call and later selected through the Request for Proposal process. The successful Consultant selected to manage this project will not be permitted to directly participate in the design or construction of the proposed works.

The submission shall contain the following information: • Company Profile and Areas of Expertise • Proposed Project Manager(s) complete with their Curriculum Vitae • Key strategies in the following areas: - Scheduling - Multiple contract co-ordination - Construction Contract Administration • Experience with Municipal infrastructure projects and wastewater treatment facilities • Approach to understanding assignment, communication, internal and external reporting, and quality assurance • List of relevant projects, complete with originally budgeted versus actual incurred project costs, as well as originally proposed versus actual schedules • List of client references
