Authority studying habitat of town

The Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority may need access to private lands along the Black River this summer.

The authority said it is studying the river's 385-square kilometre watershed as part of its efforts to improve the health of Lake Simcoe.

Rob Baldwin, LSRCA planning and environmental stewardship coordinator, said the authority will work with municipalities to develop a strategy for managing the watershed from the Oak Ridges Moraine in Whitchurch-Stouffville to the lake in Georgina.

"By taking an inventory of all natural areas and identifying vulnerable habitats, we can prioritize conservation efforts to reduce soil erosion, enhance wildlife and fisheries habitat and improve water quality," he said in a statement.
