

# Macri races to fifth place in Quebec

Whitchurch-Stouffville's Jonathan Macri piloted his NTN Bearings Swift vehicle to a fifth-place finish at last weekend's CART Toyota Atlantic race at Trois Rivières, Quebec.

Starting fifth, the 19-year-old Gormley resident moved into fourth and tried several times during the race to overtake Michael Valiante for third place, but was thwarted.

Macri also averted a potential disaster on lap 15 as he came out of corner 11 and spun. However, he managed to stay in the race and fell back into fifth place, which he held for the duration of the race. Despite the fifth-place finish and his frustration in try-

ing to overtake Valiante for third place, Macri was happy with his performance.

The team engineer Bill Fickling did a great job setting up the NTN car," he said. "I was comfortable driving it, and was confident enough to challenge for position. "I definitely enjoyed battling

with David Rutledge and Michael Valiante. "I managed to get by Rutledge. I drove clean, especially against Valiante, and don't think I deserved being shut out the way I was.

"It's tough fighting for a racing line, but once a driver commits to one and earns it, I think it's wrong for another driver to chop the line.

"In all, I had a great ride, and am walking away with some good points."

Macri is currently in fifth place in the overall championship series with 53 points and second place in the rookie points standings, just three points behind Joey Hand.
