

# Lebovic donation could pay for new soccer fields

The Lebovic deal, if completed, would not take away from the pool/library building," he added. "It's like the Air Canada Centre or Hummingbird Centre (in Toronto)."

"This will benefit taxpayers throughout the municipality," Councillor Sue Sherban said in an interview.

Sherban, who has been negotiating with Lebovic for almost a year, is a member of the indoor pool fundraising committee. Lebovic expressed interest in contributing to the new centre, after receiving one of the 220 letters the pool fundraising committee sent to Whitchurch-Stouffville businesses. To date, the committee has raised around \$169,000 for lifesaving equipment to be used at the pool.

Jeanne Major, who ran unsuccessfully for mayor last year, would rather see the centre named after "someone who has truly done community work in the past." She believes that having one name for the entire complex "undermines the contributions of others."

"People donated their land for the Markham-Stouffville Hospital without wanting something in return. That is a true community donation. This is a business deal," said Major, an executive member of RIG (Residents Information Group), a now defunct ratepayers' group that fought against the location of the new pool and library for about two years.

RIG argued that the location, in Memorial Park south of downtown Stouffville, would be too far from the centre of the community. The group hoped to have an enlarged library at the original Main Street location and have the pool located at the town's recreation

complex. RIG was also opposed to the new site because an access road had to be built, adding more cost to the project, and because the lands are located near a floodplain.

The Lebovic donation "would help us with future recreational endeavours," Kristoffy noted.

The 10-year time limit for the Lebovic proposal doesn't apply to the names of rooms within the library, such as Courtney's Corner, which will remain permanently.

Most theatres and small performing arts centres have substantial corporate sponsorship of this type, Kristoffy said. "We will see public corporations doing this more and more."

Lebovic Enterprises is building homes in southern Stouffville, south of the new complex. The Lebovics have donated money to other causes in the community, including the Strawberry Festival and cultural programs.
