This three-week session will introduce participants to a variety of embellishment techniques like pin tucking and lace inseting as they work toward the creation of a project of their choice.

The first week is the basic session: a sampler of various techniques will be created, and this sampler can be converted into an apron or cushion cover. The two following weeks provide the opportunity for studio sessions to guide participants through the construction of a Victorian-styled blouse or other project, using the heirloom sewing techniques learned in the first week.
