Emergency staff on stand-by; York's mock disaster postponed

been in the planning stages since last February.

Fisch also cited the region's pledge to have emergency staff on stand-by in the event a call for help comes from organizers of the relief effort in the U.S. The region has offered to send paramedics and other personnel if they're needed; so far, no call for help has been issued from south of the border.

The mock accident has been

postponed until next spring. Region CAO Alan Wells said despite the cancellation, the emergency exercises are regarded as valuable training and planning tools.

"The goal of the emergency exercise is to strengthen regional, municipal and other agencies' capabilities to provide an effective co-ordinated response to future emergency situations," Wells said.

Meanwhile, the American tragedy remained a focal point

for regional councillors, who observed a moment of silence prior to getting down to business at Thursday morning's meeting.

Fisch said that in the midst of all the bad news, the region's response, including the organization of a blood donor clinic at its Newmarket headquarters, was appropriate.

"I know that was a positive action, in light of all the negative things we've seen in the last 10 days," Fisch said.

In 1997, York Region completed the York-Durham Trunk Sewer Master Plan. The Master Plan recommended a number of activities necessary to upgrade the York-Durham Trunk Sewer to meet the long-term needs of the Region. The Region of York is currently constructing the Ninth Line Trunk Sewer and Phase 1 of the Sixteenth Avenue Trunk Sewer as the first component of the new parallel system for the York-Durham Sewage System. The Region of York intends to construct Phase 2 of the Sixteenth Avenue Trunk Sewer from Stone Mason Drive to Woodbine Avenue. The proposed location of the trunk sewer is shown on the map below.

The project is being undertaken in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. Consultation with the public and review agencies forms an important component of the project. To provide more detailed information and an opportunity for public comment on the study, a Public Information Centre will be held:
