

## Arrest made in video thefts

York Regional Police traveled to Durham Region on Thursday to arrest a youth charged in the theft of video games from a young boy with cystic fibrosis.

Three video game systems and 25 games were stolen from David Lamabe's home in Markham while he was spending time in Sick Children's Hospital in Toronto earlier this month.

The nine-year-old underwent a double lung transplant operation in December 1999 and has spent much of his recovery time since then playing his video games, because his physical activity is limited. Lamabe moves around mainly with the help of a four-wheel scooter.

The arrested youth, 17 years old, was charged with break-and-enter and theft and breach of probation.
