

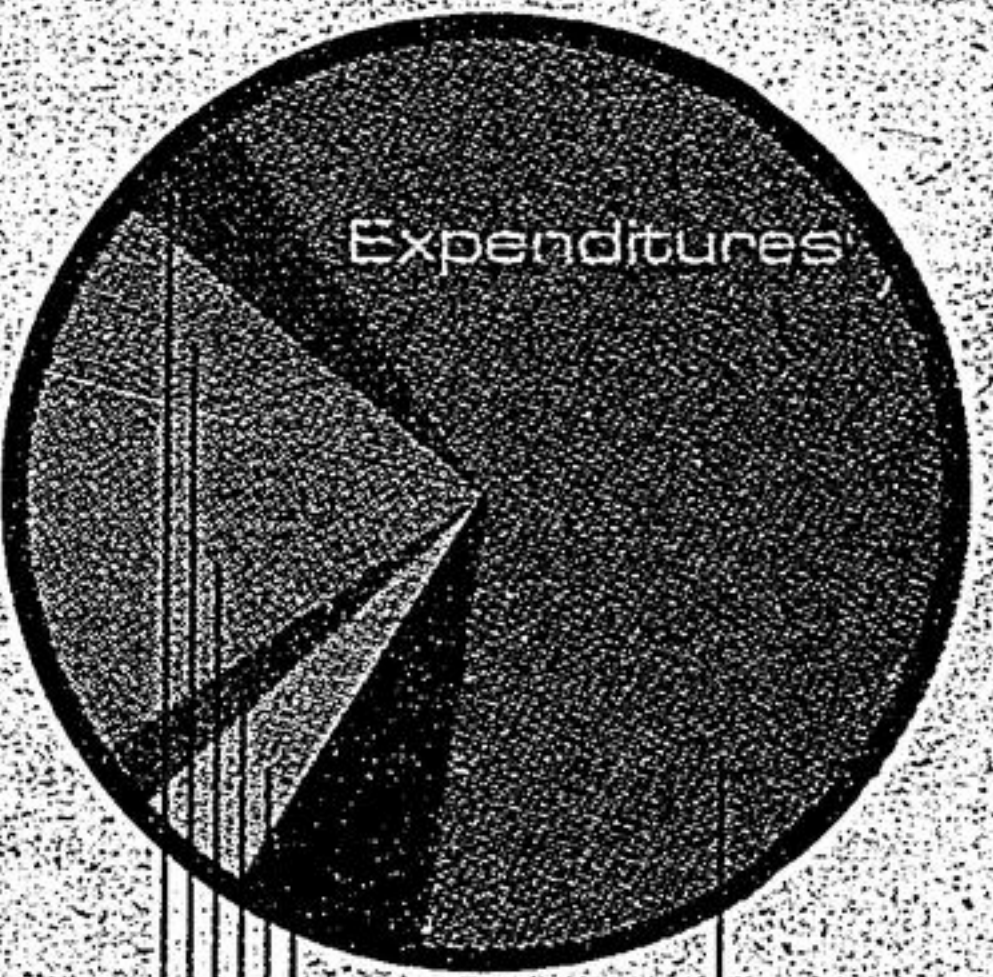
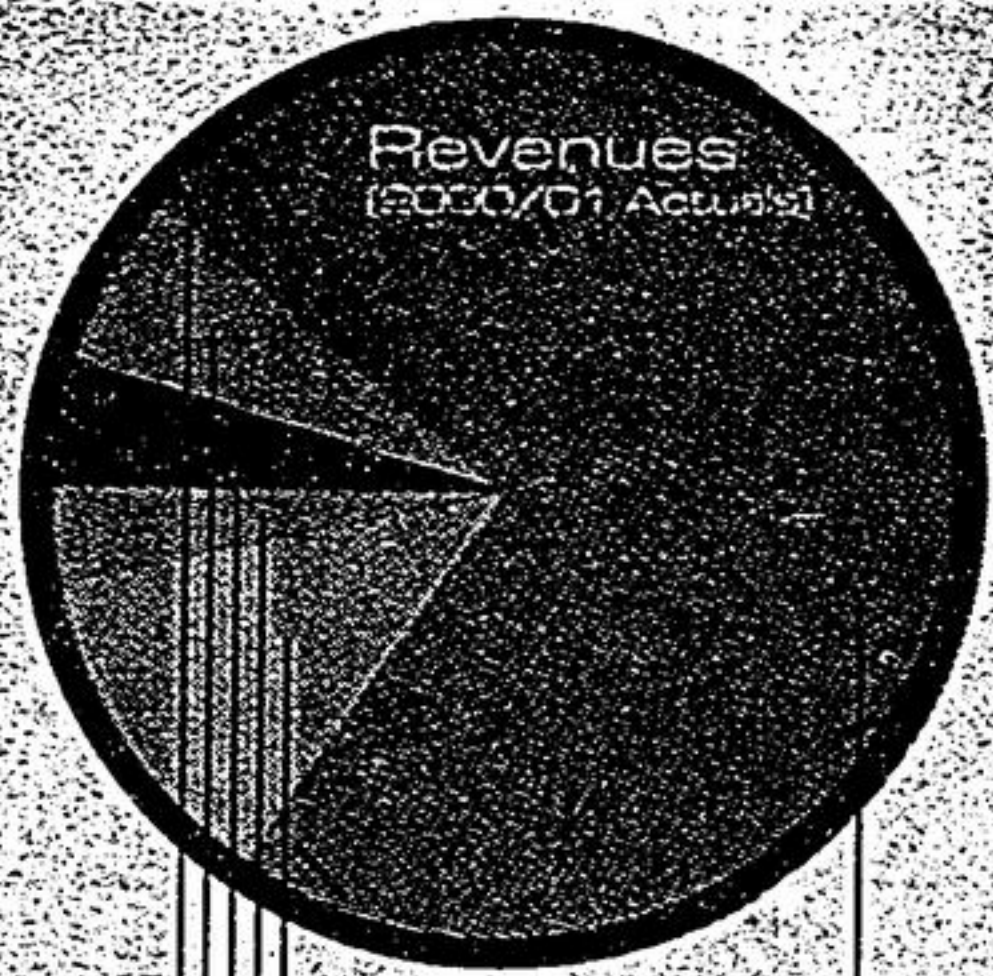

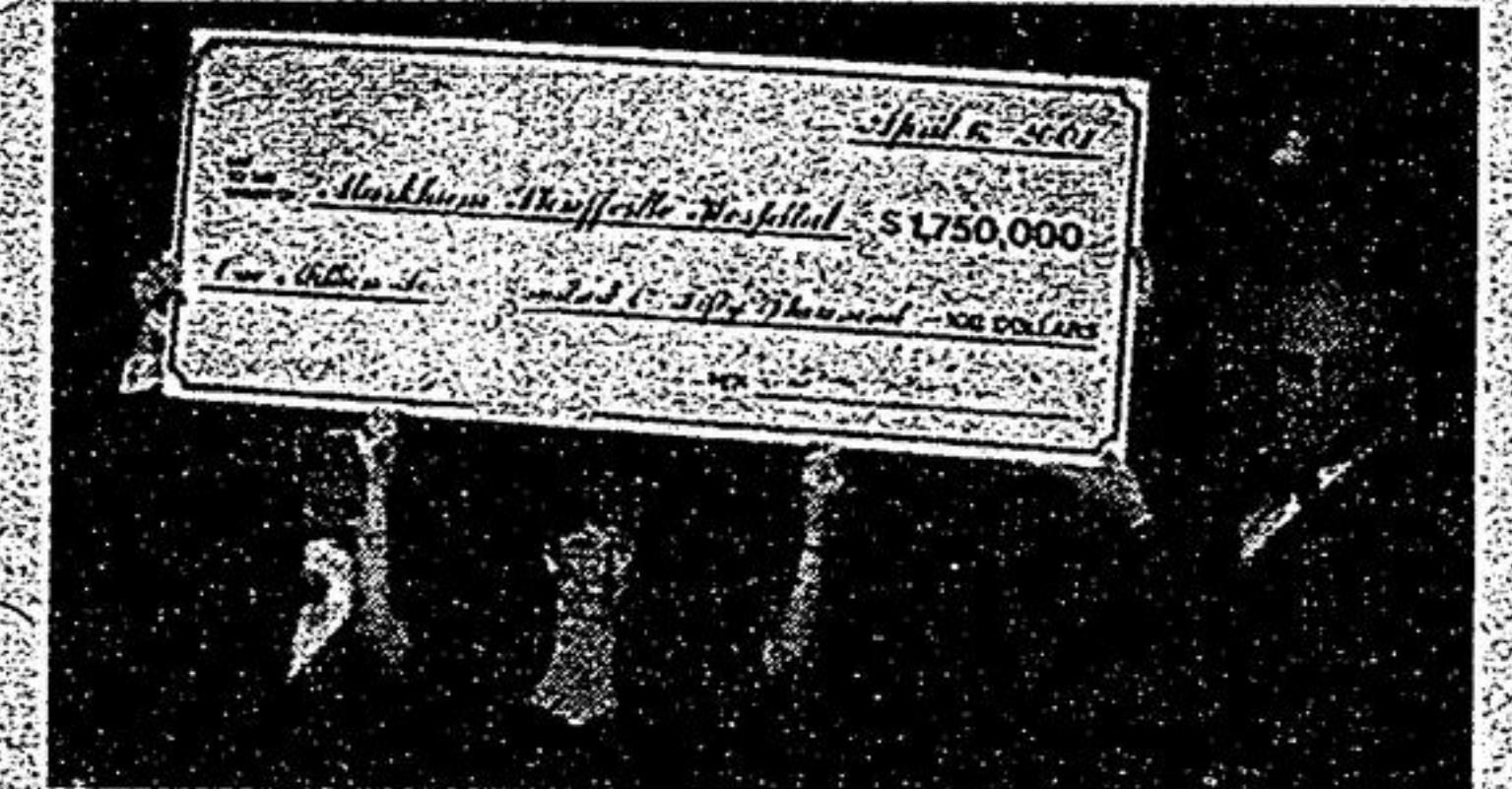

place to be able to find the funds for the Hospital's upcoming redevelopment project, and still be able to assist with annual capital equipment needs. Over the next year



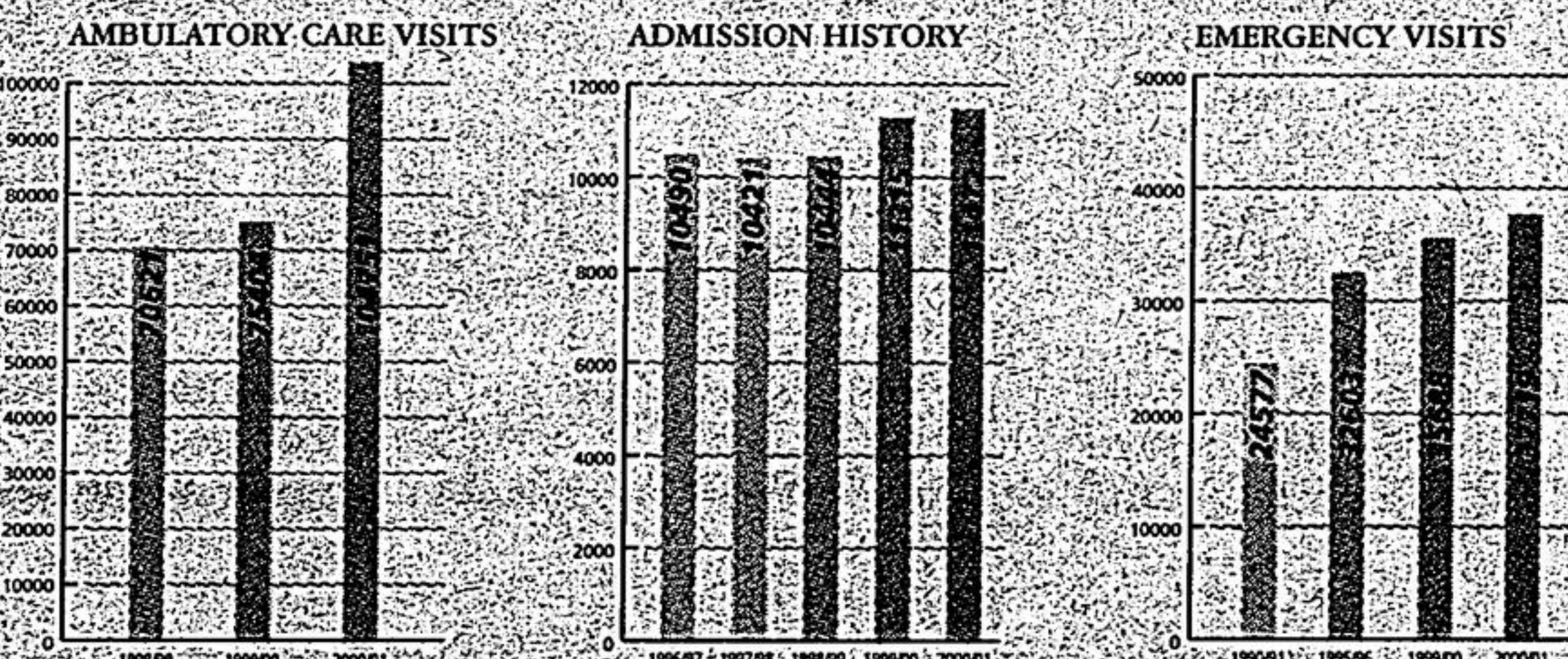
we will be working on enhancing our existing programs, strengthening relationships and partnerships and identifying new sources of funds.
