#### The Second Instalment of the 2001 COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL & MULTI-RESIDENTIAL TAXES

are due on or before  
**November 16th, 2001**

TAX PAYMENTS may be made by mail, or in person at the Town Office and at most Financial Institutions through tellers, banking machines and by telephone. Banking fees may apply. Penalty will be charged and added to your tax account at our office on payments made at the bank after the due dates. After hours tax payments may be made in the drop box at the front west entrance door of the Imperial Building (37 Sandiford Drive).

**THE PENALTY** charged for non-payment of 2001 taxes is one and one-quarter (1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

27, and George Espinosa, 24.

The driver of the Hyundai, a 31-year-old Toronto man, was airlifted by helicopter to Sunnybrook Health Science

Centre in Toronto, where he was listed in serious but stable condition.

No injuries to the crew or passengers on the train were reported.

Whitchurch-Stouffville firefighters assisted at the scene.
