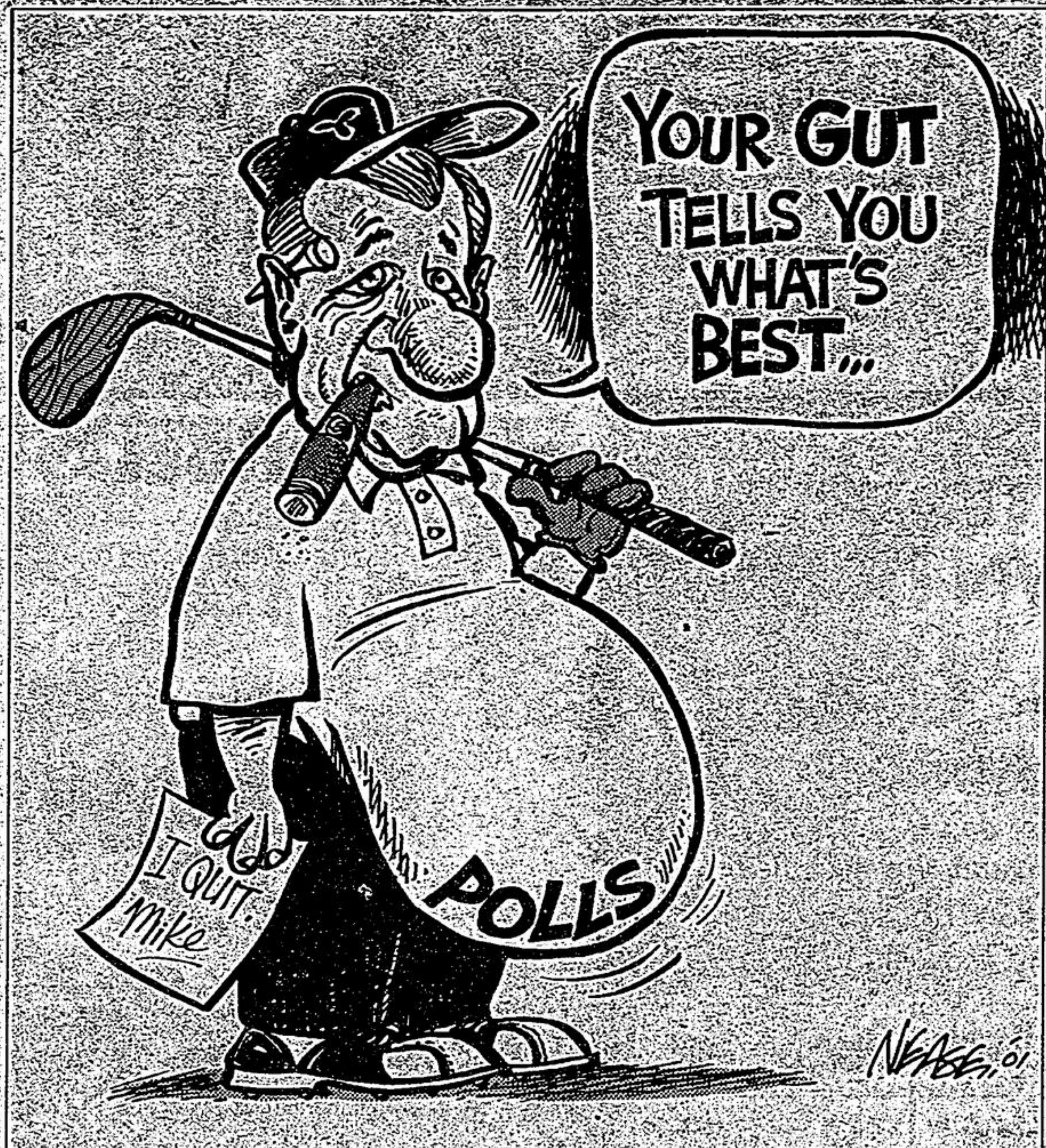
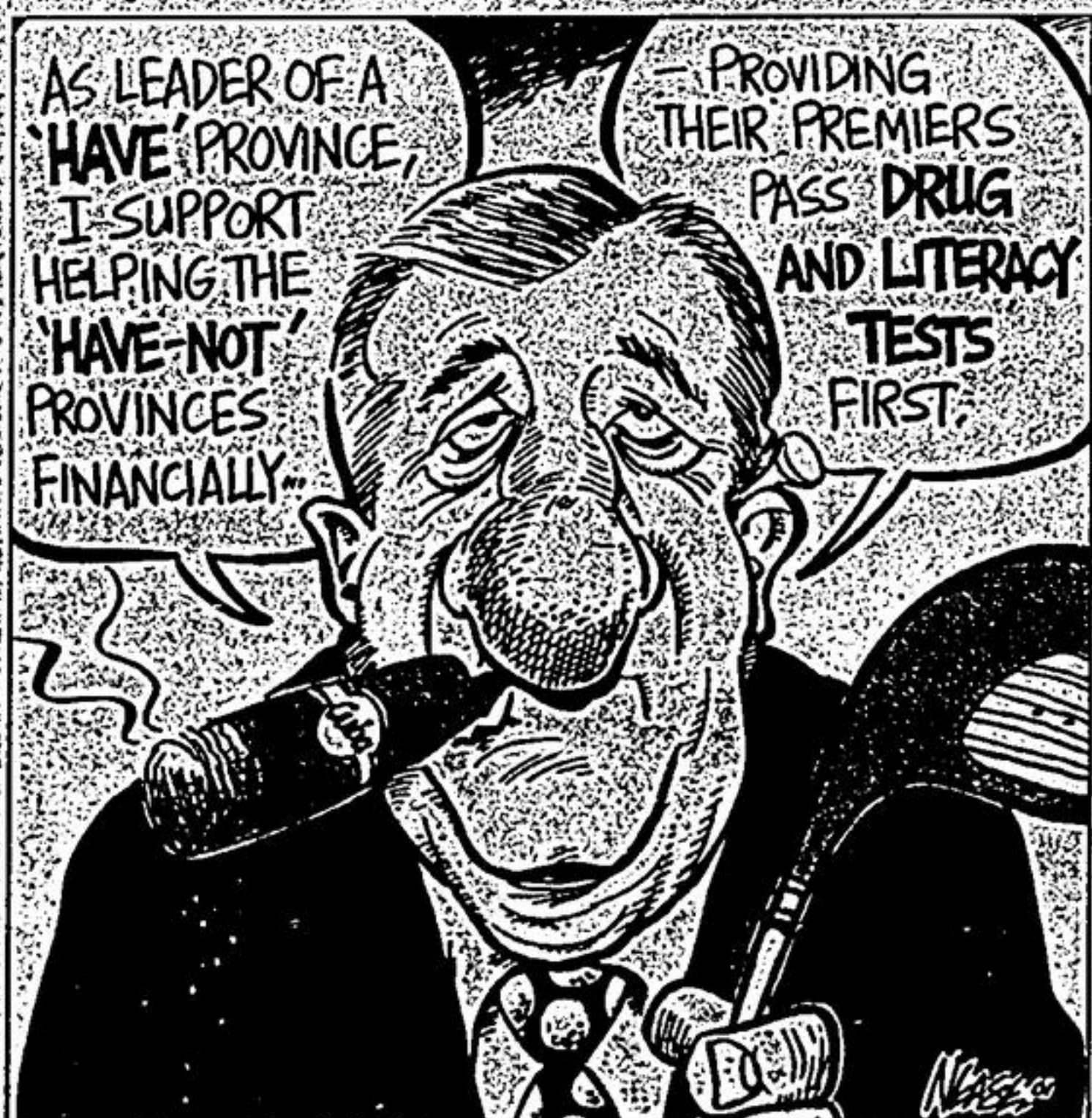
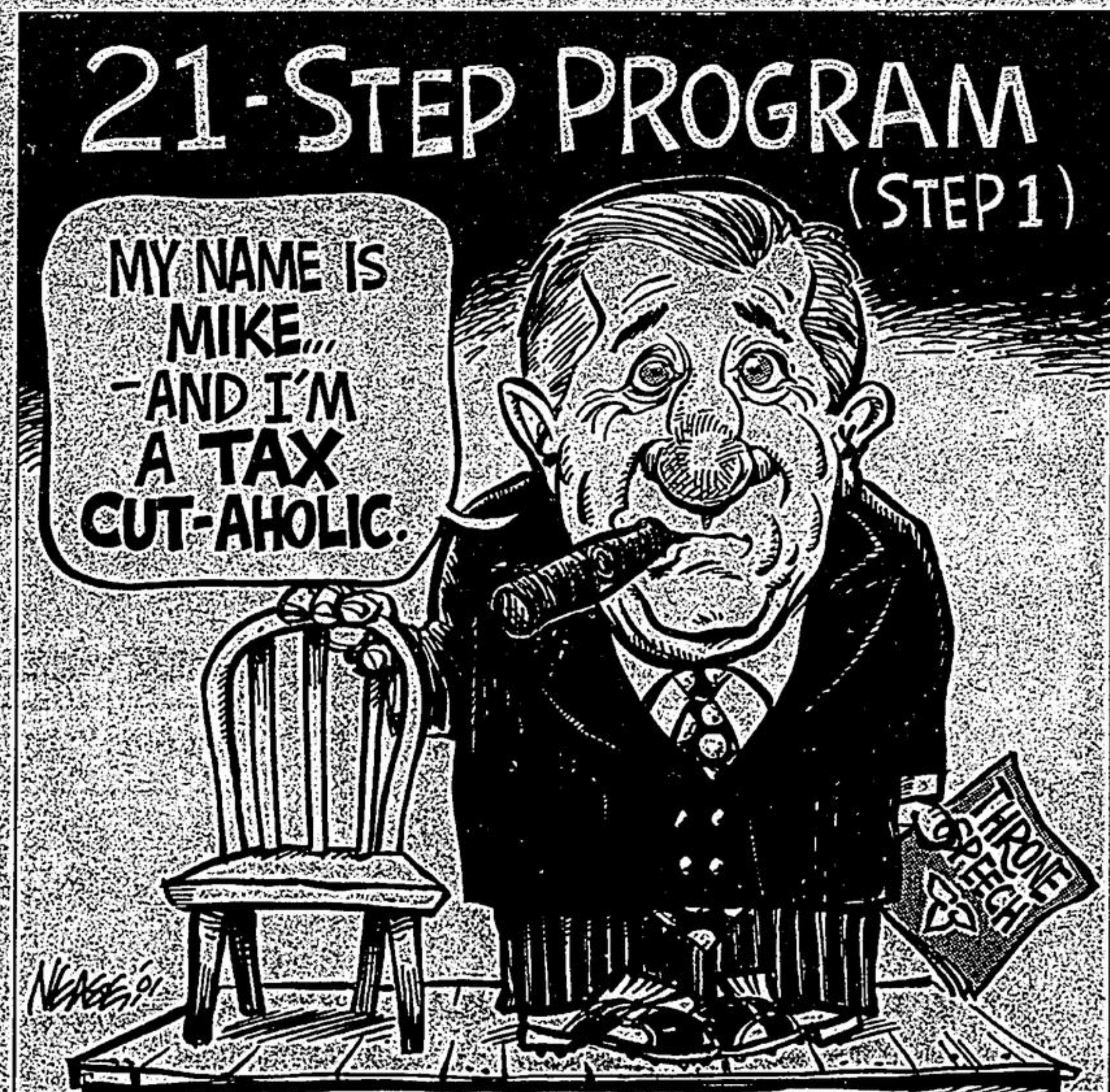
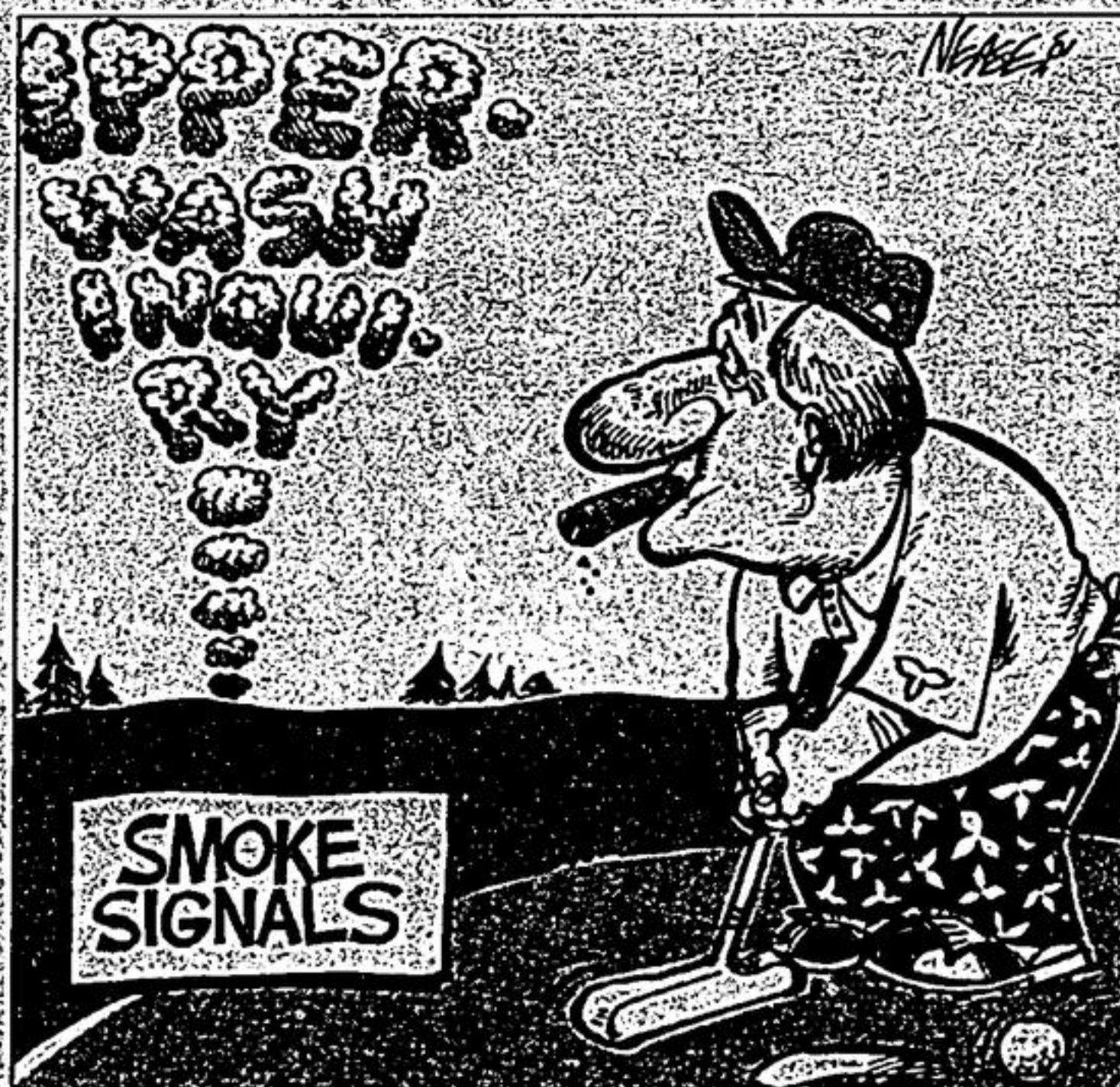
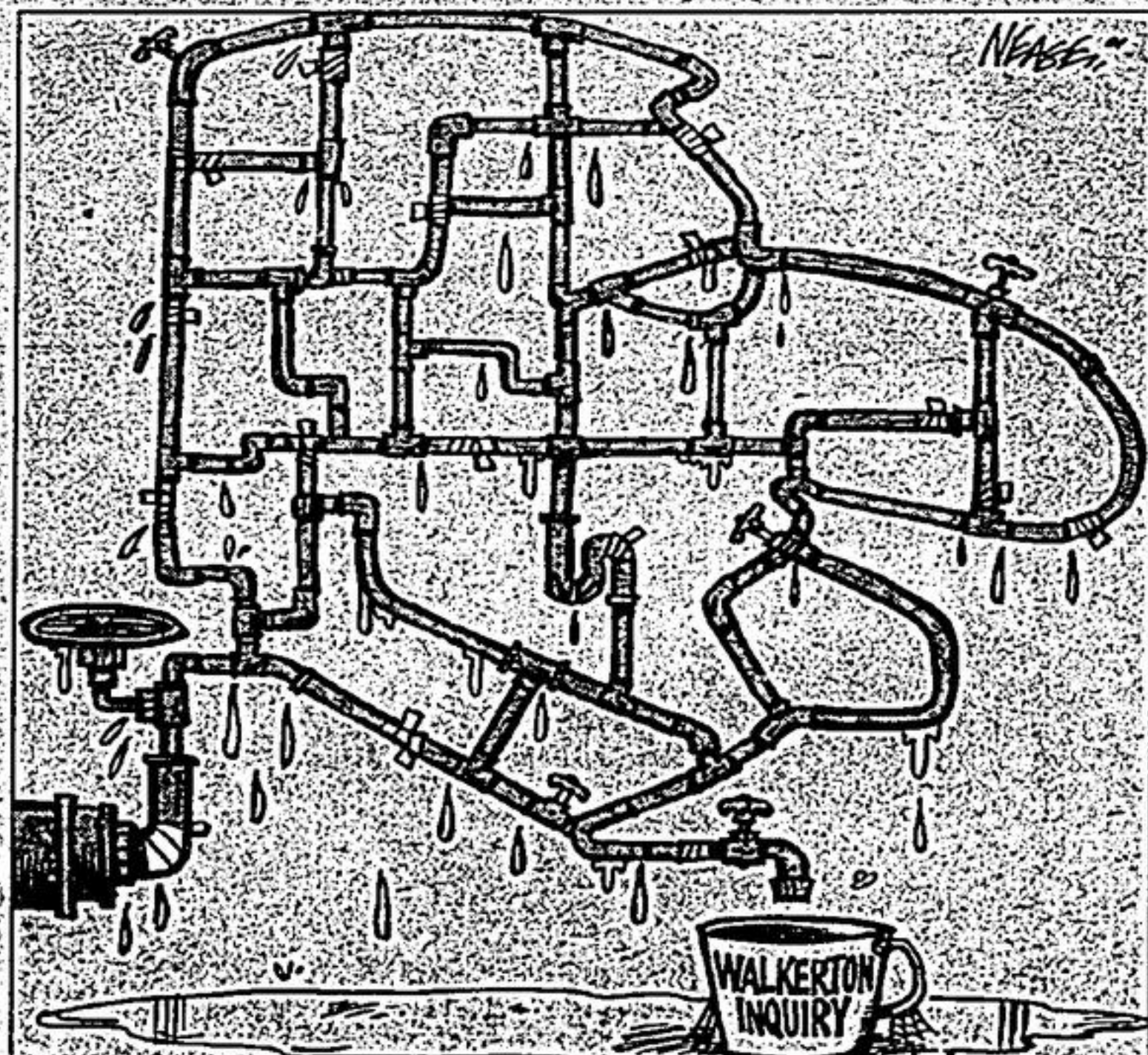


THE BEST OF NEASE: A YEAR IN THE LIFE OF PREMIER MIKE HARRIS
