

Assessment growth provides some relief for region taxpayers

to be onerous for the York Region taxpayer."

Mitigating these spiraling costs, for this year at least, is a substantial five per cent increase in assessment growth.

That represents some \$20 million in new revenues for the region and helps offset the burden that's passed on to taxpayers.

Cousens recognizes this kind of growth can't be banked on forever. In fact, regional staff predicts a lower rate of growth in York's future assessment base.

That means an austere approach to future budgeting. Preliminary figures call for a 1.8 per cent tax hike in 2003 and a one per cent increase in 2004.

Those targets are attainable if the region follows a business plan it has been working on, Cousens said.

"We have to do everything we can to scale back our expectations and our costs," he said.

D'Aversa argues better planning by the region in the past would have helped avoid a tax increase this year. She advises a prudent approach to avoid painful tax hikes in the future.

"Right now the economy's great. Let's be very conservative," she said.

"Let's spend it on the priorities and forget about the little frills.

"I can just imagine where we're going to be when the economy isn't as strong as it is today," D'Aversa said.


