

Gas station attendant robbed at knifepoint

A lone cashier working the counter at the Shell gas station at McCowan Road and 16th Avenue in

Markham was robbed at knifepoint early Sunday morning.

A single suspect wearing a white rubber mask entered the station about 3:30 a.m., pulled a knife and demanded

cash. He removed the money from the till, then proceeded to rob the cashier as well, before fleeing westbound on 16th Avenue.

He's described as six-feet, 191 pounds, wearing the mask, a blue-hooded sweat-shirt and grey jeans.

Thieves covered window during heist

Police are looking for an

unknown number of determined suspects who cut their way through the dry-wall of two connecting business units to steal \$45,000 worth of shoes early Friday morning.

Police said suspects entered a vacant unit in the plaza at 3229 Hwy. 7 by spinning the lock, then cut a hole in a wall to enter the neighboring unit, The Peking House restaurant.

They cut another hole in the drywall of the restaurant's kitchen supply area to enter the next unit, Best Shoes.

They covered the glass window with brown paper to avoid notice by passers-by, then stuffed hundreds of pairs of shoes into garbage bags before fleeing through a rear door.

Damage is estimated at \$1,000.

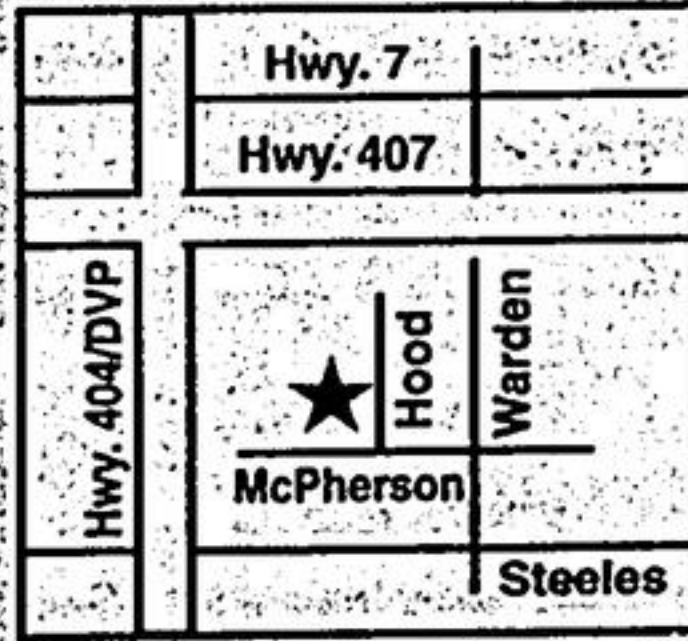

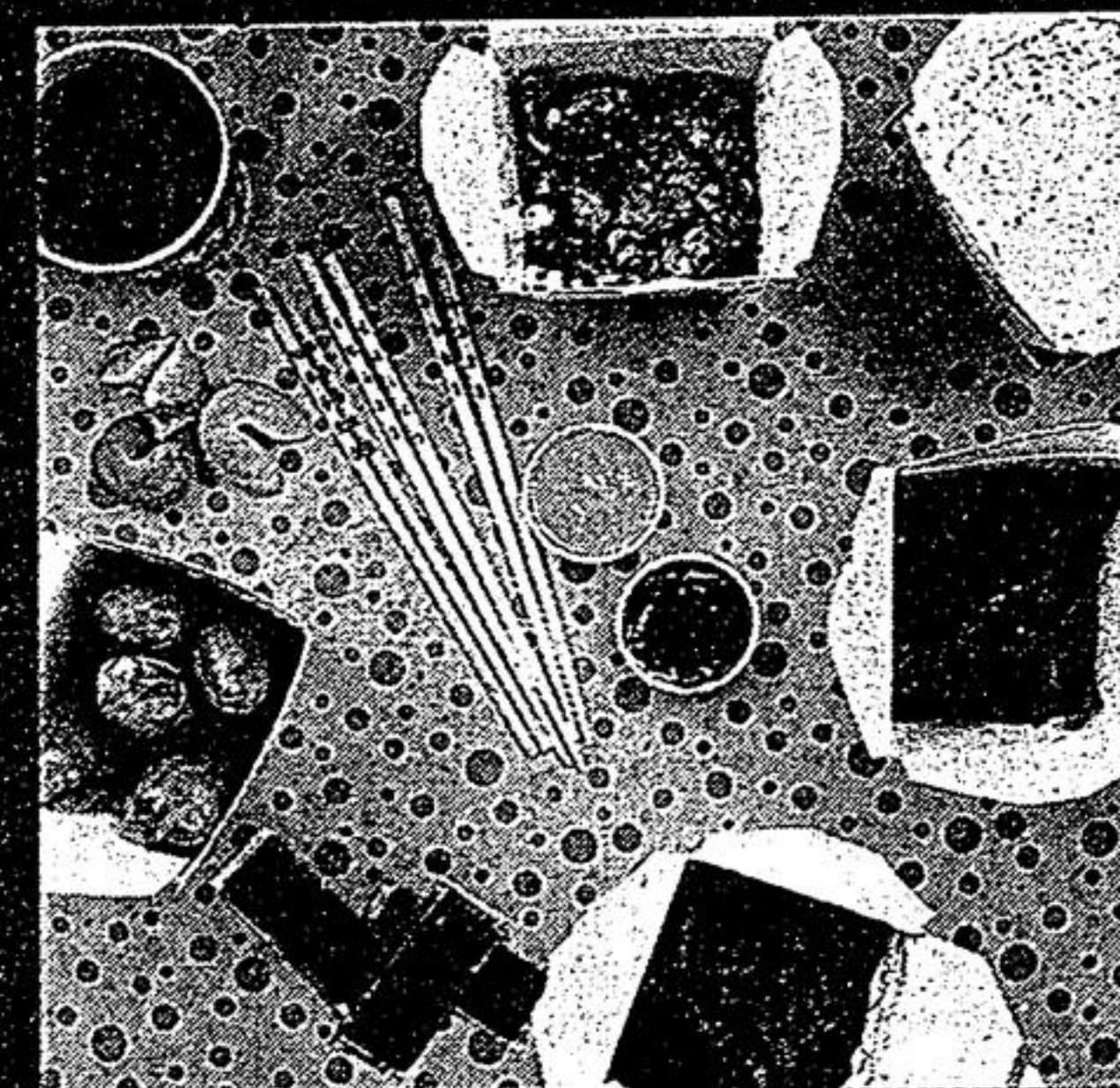
