Indy racer helps open new Motorola facility

Another high-tech company has made Markham its home.

Motorola Canada officially opened its new Canadian headquarters at Hwy. 407 and Warden Avenue on Tuesday. Four hundred employees moved from four Motorola premises in Mississauga to work in the 224,000-square-foot facility.

As well as corporate headquarters, the building houses five units, including three for research and development.

"We believe the outstanding market leadership and research performed at the new Markham facility will have a significant impact on our products and services

and result in tangible benefits for our customers," said Bob Bigony, senior vice-president and regional president.

Markham Mayor Don Cousens said, "We're pleased to have Motorola Canada join our business community. Markham has a thriving and growing high-tech community and this is exactly the kind of business we want to continue to attract and see flourish here."

Team Motorola racing driver Michael Andretti, seven-time winner of the Toronto Molson Indy was also on hand for the opening.

Motorola Canada's distribution and repair operations will continue to operate from an existing facility in Mississauga.
